- 2. In this regard, the QAD EPS are expected to ensure that schools in their respective SDO assignment are operating in full compliance with DepEd policies, guidelines, requirements, and standards in terms of the following applications:
 - A. Establishment, Merging, Conversion, Naming/Renaming of Public Schools, and Separation of Public School Annexes (DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2014 and DO 51, s. 2015);
 - B. Government Permit to Operate and Government Recognition for Private Schools;
 - C. Reissuance of Certificate of Recognition to Private Schools due to Change of School Name/School Site/After 50 Years of Corporate Existence;
 - D. Increase in Tuition and Other Fees of Private Schools;
 - E. Acknowledgment of Private School Closure (Permanent/Temporary); and
 - F. Issuance of Special Order for the Eligibility of Graduation in Private Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and Technical-Vocational Institutions.
- 3. QAD EPS are also advised to carry out a seamless transition of work assignment by ensuring the proper turnover of record and provision of guidance to fellow EPS and SDO counterpart personnel as necessary.
- 4. Issues and concerns of Interested Parties on QAD programs and services shall be communicated to this Office through the EPS in charge, for appropriate action.
- 5. All other provisions indicated in the enclosed Regional Memorandum No. NCR-634, s. 2022 shall remain in effect.
