



SUBJECT : CLMD-CID Quarterly Convergence

In view of the implementation of the Learning Continuity and Recovery Plan (LCRP), this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will hold the above-captioned activity, via hybrid modality.

The purpose of the activity is twofold – 1) to recognize research initiatives of the Division/schools in relation with the interventions currently being conducted or completed to address gaps; and 2) create an opportunity for curriculum implementers to benchmark effective interventions for different types of learners. As earlier agreed with the CID Chiefs, the following are the schedules of quarterly convergence and the four (4) Divisions assigned in each Quarter to share their research initiatives/findings, to wit:
