SPEAKERS

Dr. Cielito F. Habito is the Chairman of Brain Trust Inc. He is the former Socio-Economic Planning Secretary of the Fidel V. Ramos administration and a current professor of the ADMU Department of Economics. As the Director-General of the National Economic and Development Authority from 1992 to 1998, he was instrumental in the successful macroeconomic policies of the Ramos presidency. Dr. Habito has a master's degree and a Doctor of Philosophy in economics from Harvard University.

Prof. Edgar T. Valenzuela is an Adjunct Professor of the Ateneo School of Government and a lecturer at the ADMU Department of Economics. He has been the Coordinator for the "SDG2 Zero Hunger" project of the Sustainable Development Solutions Network Philippines since February 2023. He has 40 years of development and food security advocacy, through his involvement in the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO/UN) in Bangkok (1979-1982) and in Rome (1990-2012); Asian NGO Coalition for Agrarian Reform and Rural Development (1983-1990); and Asian Development Bank (2016-2018).
