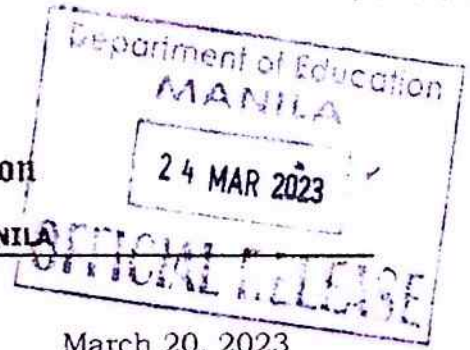

1. Manila Secondary Science Research Advisers Association (MSSRAA) and Manila Robotics Society (MRS) will be in charge of organizing the contests for teachers and students joining the following categories:

2. Each school should send only one project per category, regardless of grade level, with each project entry not exceeding to three members. This is open to all elementary, secondary, and senior high schools in both public and private schools.

4. Each project should prepare and submit the following:

COPYRIGHT CATEGORY

Specific Guidelines:

This is open to all teachers and administrators in both elementary, secondary and senior high schools (public and private schools).

Literary Works

- a. Books, pamphlets, articles and other writings;
- b. Periodicals and newspapers;
- c. Lectures, sermons, addresses, dissertations prepared for oral delivery, whether or not reduced in writing or other material form;
- d. Letters
- e. Action Researches

The eligible entries must be submitted to MIPIBEX organizers at Timoteo Paez Integrated School on or before March 20, 2023 to April 5, 2023.

Artistic Works dramatic or dramatico-musical compositions; choreographic works or entertainment in shows:

1. Musical compositions, with or without words;
2. Works of drawing, painting, architecture, sculpture, engraving, lithography or other works of art; models or designs for works of art;
3. Original ornamental designs or models for articles of manufacture, whether or not registrable as an industrial design, and other works of applied art;
4. Illustrations, maps, plans, sketches, charts and three-dimensional works relative to geography, topography, architecture or science;
5. Drawings or plastic works of a scientific or technical character;
6. Photographic works including works produced by a process analogous to photography, lantern slides;
7. Audiovisual works and cinematographic works and works produced by a process for making audio-visual recordings;
8. Pictorial illustrations and advertisements;
9. Computer programs;
10. Other literary, scholarly, scientific and artistic works and;
11. Derivative Works. The following derivative works shall also be protected by copyright the following:
 - a. Dramatization, translations, adaptations, arrangements, and other alterations of literary or artistic works; and
 - b. Collections of literary, scholarly or artistic works, and compilations of data and other materials which are original by reason of the selection or coordination or arrangement of their contents.

SONG WRITING CONTEST

Specific Guidelines:

1. The competition is open to all bona fide high school learners in the Division of City Schools - Manila.
2. Contestants (song writer and the singer/performers) should submit a PDF file of e-certification with e-signature of the Principal inclusive of 1x1 photos of the contestant/s and teacher-coach at the bottom side of the document.
3. Each school may submit several entries.
4. The song must have a minimum duration of at least three minutes but not more than five minutes.
5. The lyrics and melody of the song should be original. Any genre is welcome.
6. The song must not contain any vulgar, inappropriate, or offensive language.
7. The performer of the song may not be the composer itself, but it should still be bona fide student/s of the same school.
8. Deadline of online registration and submission of entries (written song with chords and video recording) will be on April 5, 2023. Follow the requirements below (under bullet III. REQUIREMENTS)
9. There is only one composer/song writer allowed per entry and one up to two performers for the song is acceptable.
10. All qualified participants and teacher-coach will be given e-certificates.
11. There will be three winners for the song writer and three winners for the best performer of the composed song. All winners will receive cash prize, and trophies.
12. All the winning songs will be the official music for the opening ceremony of MIPIBIEX on April 21, 2023.
13. The decision of the board of Judges is final.
14. Any violations to these guidelines may be subject to disqualification.

For the musical choreographic works:

This is open to all students and teachers in both public and private. The music should be original and related to the Theme: "Manila FIRST: Fostering, Innovation, Research, Science, and Technology." The length should not exceed five minutes. This can be performed live and in digital form.

SOCIAL INNOVATION CATEGORY

The aforementioned category focuses on **The Young Mayor Competition-Planning a Clean and Green Township-City in Manila**. The teams will have a short 20 minute oral presentation of the project to explain their vision to the panel of judges on how clean and green Manila would look like in the future. 2. Each school may submit entries in the form of computer-aided drawing, free-hand drawing, 3-dimensional drawings, drawings, pencil-drawings, product image drawings and models.
3. Each entry may indicate, but not limited to innovative designs which identify and deliver new products and services that Improve the quality of life of individuals in the community.
4. The **Urban Planning Design Proposal** write up (English or Filipino) should be in an A4 size paper. Make sure that the text is readable, and the pictures are clear to be submitted in a PDF file bearing e-signature of the author/s or proponent/s with Executive Summary. (Rationale/ Purpose/ Design Description/ Work ability/ Anticipated Issues and Challenges/ Value and Contribution) of not more than five pages.
5. Each school may submit several entries.
6. All entries should adhere to Republic Act 8293 otherwise known as **Intellectual Property Code of the Philippines**.
7. Save the entry in this file format: **UPDESIGN_ Title _Proponent_ School** and send it to the competition e-mail(sdvchem@yahoo.com) on or before April 5, 2023.
8. All qualified entries will be given e-certificates.

9. There will be three winners to be chosen (Gold, Silver, and Bronze). All winners will receive medals and/or plaque

10. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

11. Any violation to these guidelines may be subject to disqualification.

12. The contest organizers shall not be responsible for late, lost, damaged, misdirected, stolen, or misappropriated entries.
