MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into on 20TH day of MARCH 2023 in Quezon City by and between:

MANILA WATER COMPANY, INC., a corporation duly organized and existing under Philippine laws, with principal office address at MWSS Administration Building, 489 Katipunan Road, Balara, Quezon City, represented by its President and Chief Executive Officer, **J.V. Emmanuel A. de Dios**, and its Chief Operating Officer for the East Zone, **Arnold Jether A. Mortera**, duly authorized for this purpose as evidenced by its Secretary's Certificate dated January 10, 2023, hereinafter referred to as "**Manila Water**";

-and-

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION-NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION, a government agency of the Philippine Government, with address at Misamis St., Bago Bantay Quezon City, represented by its Regional Director, **Wilfredo E. Cabral**, hereinafter referred to as the "**DepEd NCR**";

Each a Party; collectively, the Parties.

RECITALS

Manila Water is a public utility with a legislative franchise under Republic Act No. 11601, "An Act Granting Manila Water Company, Inc. a Franchise to Establish, Operate, and Maintain the Waterworks and Sewerage System in the East Zone Service Area of Metro Manila and Province of Rizal" and is a concessionaire of Manila Water Sewerage System.

Manila Water is devoted to its social and educational programs, one of which is the **SALIN - Lakbayan Para sa mga Guro Program** ("SALIN Program"), a teachers' advocacy program which involves an educational and experiential tour of Manila Water's treatment facilities that aims to enrich and augment our teacher's knowledge on water and wastewater management, and to reinforce the importance of environmental protection and the responsible use of water. The SALIN Program will include talks on water and wastewater management plus other environmental and sustainability programs of Manila Water.

DepEd NCR expressed its interest to partner with Manila Water on the execution of the SALIN Program by allowing its teachers to participate in the said program.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and their mutual covenants, the **PARTIES** hereby agree as follows:

1. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF MANILA WATER

1.1 Manila Water shall be responsible for the following:

- a. Conduct of regular SALIN Program sessions with group of teachers from DepEd NCR ("Participants") scheduled every quarter.
- b. Provide transportation from certain pick-up points to the venue and vice-versa, and refreshments during the SALIN program.
- c. Conduct Information, Education and Communication (IEC) sessions / Mobile Lakbayan to participating DepEd NCR schools.
- d. Promote water, wastewater, environmental and sustainability related programs of the DepEd NCR on Manila Water's social media platforms and website.
- e. Send year-end accomplishment reports to DepEd NCR relative to the SALIN Program, as requested.
- f. Provide Teaching/Instructional Materials relevant to water and wastewater process, and the water trail.
- g. Require minimal personal information from the Participants for the health checklist,

2.1 DepEd NCR shall be responsible for the following:

- a. Actively participate in Manila Water's SALIN Program and other relevant programs by attending and actively joining in IEC sessions and Mobile Lakbayan.
- b. Encourage voluntary participation of learning partners in the IEC sessions and Mobile Lakbayan.
- c. Urge learning participants to share the knowledge they acquired during the learning sessions to their students and community.
- d. Promote and advocate for Manila Water's Programs through publication of the project in the DepEd NCR social media platforms and website.
- e. Include Manila Water's logo in select online and print marketing materials that will be produced by the DepEd NCR.
- f. Support Manila Water's Programs by urging the participation and involvement of its personnel in the institution.
- g. Provide feedback on the conduct of the SALIN Program to assess and improve its implementation.

3. OTHER CONDITIONS

3.1 Each Party shall bear its own costs/expenses relative to the implementation of the Agreement and conduct of the Program, except insofar as costs/expenses agreed to be shared which agreement shall be in writing.

3.2 This Agreement shall be effective for a period of four (4) years from the date of execution hereof ("Term").

3.3 The Agreement may be terminated upon expiration of the Term, or upon service of a prior written notice of pre-termination by either Party at least thirty (30) days from the intended date of termination.

3.4 Participation in the SALIN Program is free-of-charge and voluntary on the part of the Participants. Participants are required to follow health protocols, and safety guidelines.

3.5 Manila Water will not be liable for injuries or damages resulting from acts, omissions or negligence of the Participants.

3.6 The Parties shall process all personal data necessary for the execution of or pursuant to the implementation of this Agreement in compliance with Republic Act No. 10173, otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act of 2012, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, issuances of the National Privacy Commission, and all other applicable laws.

3.7 The signatories to this Agreement represent that they are duly authorized to represent and bind their respective principals in signing this Agreement.

3.8 Any amendment to this Agreement shall be made in writing duly signed by the parties hereto before it can be valid and enforceable between the Parties, including their corresponding agents, successors, administrators, and assignees.

3.9 The violation or omission of any of the provisions of this Agreement shall be ground for the cancellation or rescission of the same without need for legal or court action.




3.10 If at any time a dispute or difference shall arise among the Parties in connection with this Agreement, the Parties shall, in good faith, exert all efforts to resolve such dispute or difference. At the request of a Party by giving notice to the others, the duly authorized representatives of all the Parties shall meet in a good-faith effort to reach an amicable settlement of the dispute or difference. In the event of suit arising from this Agreement, the Parties agree that the venue of the action shall be vested exclusively in any of the competent courts in Quezon City to the exclusion of all other courts.

3.11 The failure by one party to require performance of any provision of this Agreement shall not affect that party's right to require performance at any time thereafter, nor shall a waiver of any breach or default of this Agreement constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach or default or a waiver of the provision itself.

3.12 In case any of the provision contained in this Agreement shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable, in any respect, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.

3.13 This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together will constitute one and the same amendment.
