The Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) shall release the revised Special Program for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (SP STEM) Curriculum to address curricular and policy concerns specific to the Special Science Elementary School (SSES), Special Curricular Program for Science, Technology, and Engineering (STE), Regional Science High School (RSHS), and Legislated Science High Schools (LSHS).

In this light, the BCD will conduct a **Consultative Forum Workshop on the Revision of the Special Program for STEM Curriculum on May 3 to 5, 2023 to be attended by SP STEM Implementer and STEM Regional Focal Persons.**

The workshop aims to:

- review the current draft special program curriculum and identify areas that require improvement or modification;
- gather feedback and input from various stakeholders, including teachers, students, parents, and education experts, on the proposed changes to the special program curriculum;
- draft the proposal for a revised curriculum that is aligned with the needs and interests of the learner and promotes the development of critical thinking, problem-solving, and other key skills that are essential for success in the 21st century; and
- ensure that the revised special program curriculum aligns with the broader goals and objectives of the K to 12 Basic Education System.

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The STEM Regional Focal Persons/Representatives are also requested to prepare a **10-minute presentation** of one of its regional initiatives in addressing SP STEM Curriculum implementation challenges to be presented during the workshop.
