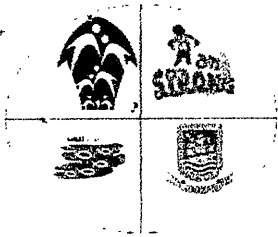

Greetings from your CACHET FAMILY!

1. FAMILY SPORTS AND GAMES FESTIVAL.

In anticipation of the end of the school year, Campaign for Character Education Tenacity (CACHET) Program, Alalay sa Pamilya at Bayan Foundation (APB), in partnership with the University of Asia and the Pacific (UA&P), intends to hold a one-day Family Sports and Games (FSG) Festival, at the UA&P Parking and Sports Building, on Saturday, 27 May, from 8:30 a.m. (arrival and light breakfast) to 5:00 p.m. (return to the station). The sponsor will be the HENRY V. MORAN FOUNDATION, INC.

2. EVENTS.

The following family or team sports and games (events and sequencing, including simultaneity of events; round robin or semi-finals-finals; event and game duration; scoring system for overall totals; team composition, and other variables) shall be determined based on the disposition of the participating divisions, schools. And individuals. The overall order of the day and house organization shall be determined once the deadline for expression of disposition is reached and the numbers determined.

The deadline of submission of interest in joining in principle and by game or event is being set for Friday, 05 May.

3. The Festival shall be an UNITAS FAMILIAE (“Unity of the Family”, a wordplay of the respective slogans of UA&P and APB) competition involving some 300 to 350 pupils, students, teachers, coaches, and parents (fathers and/or mothers) from an expected participation of 70 to 80 CACHET schools with active CACHET clubs. The participants from varied sectors shall be divided into six HOUSES of more or less 50 individuals or 20 families each from a cluster of five schools, either from one or several divisions.

To sum up:

350 maximum number of participants including the Technical Working Group from some 70 to 80 CACHET schools with CACHET Clubs. This would determine the number of light breakfast-lunch-afternoon snack packs (350 packs)

Six Family Houses, each with 50 to 60 individuals from **across** five schools from one or a cluster of divisions. This would determine the number of medals (60 pieces) and the number of small trophies for the schools (five pieces).

Special awards of recognition may be given to those schools with the highest number of participating individuals across sectors; highest number of families; and highest number of team parlor events won.


4. AWARD TOKENS. While this undertaking is mainly a FESTIVAL rather than a COMPETITION, there shall be token prizes for the winning houses and schools in the form of medals and trophies.

TWO HUMAN VIRTUES: Sportsmanship, or human elegance in victory or defeat; and Sporting Spirit, or persevering to win up to the buzzer or the bell no matter how difficult scores could be overcome.

Please note that the school level NEED NOT COMPLETE teams for any sports, since teams shall be inter-school in composition. There can be as many players as disposed of for every event. Conflicts in the schedule of events for individuals shall be resolved by the Organizing Committee.

DO STRIVE TO COME IN FULL FORCE, CACHET CLUB COACHES, OFFICERS, AND MEMBERS! Let’s help put a huge exclamatory mark on the ending of the CACHET school year.
