The Commission on Population Development (POPCOM) and the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) are currently spearheading the pilot implementation of the Social Protection Program for Adolescent Mothers and their Children (SPPAMC). SPPAMC is a social protection program for adolescent mothers, especially minors, and their children, which aims to support the continuing education, skills development, and employment of adolescent mothers to improve their capacity and opportunity for socioeconomic development.

The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration endorsed the aforementioned program to BAE through Memorandum No. OUA-OUT-021723-009 dated February 17, 2023.

The SPPAMC is being implemented in the following areas with the provision of conditional financial assistance:
