10. **Service and Volunteerism** - “Building a Better World Together: The Inspiring Role of Service and Volunteerism in Building a New Civilization of One Family Under God”



11. **Peace, Security, and Good Governance** - "Securing a Shared Future: The Critical Role of Peace, Security, and Good Governance in Building a New Civilization of One Family Under God (Emphasis on the Concerns and Support for the Unification of North and South Korea, the Plight of the Ukrainian Families, and the plight of our Uigur Families)"
12. **Tribal Families** - "Preserving Traditions, Enriching Diversity: The Vital Contribution of Indigenous Families to Building a New Civilization of One Family Under God"
13. **Executives in Education** – "Leading the Change: The Visionary Role of Education Executives in Building a New Civilization of One Family Under God"

RATIONALE

A New Age, A New Civilization is Dawning

We are entering a new age, a new civilization, that needs to be genuinely shaped with divine universal principles and values. There are clear signs and facts indicating the coming of this new civilization, as indicated below:

No matter how mother nature treats us back, because of our malpractices with our environment, there is a message in the atmosphere that calls us to come together. To change our ways and save mother earth, for this is our common home, and it is the only one we got. Global concerns for global warming, saving the rain forests, no plastic policy to save sea animals, rehabilitation and reforestation of mangroves, clean water act, clean air act, reforestation, etc., are indications of growing global cooperation and unity.

Cyberspace Technology has brought an explosion of information into every aspect of our lives. The continuous advancement of Science and Technology greatly impacts all segments of society. The world becomes a small global village, where information is readily available at our fingertips in real time. The universe has made our planet much smaller and continuously shrinking. While living in the Earth's southern hemisphere, one can enroll in Ivy universities in the northern hemisphere and even communicate with other parties working in the outer space laboratory.

The UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs 2030) should be faithfully attained by all nations of the world to have a better world to live in.

These are indicators that we have embarked into a new age where a new civilization is rising for one global human family.

A GOD-CENTERED CIVILIZATION

Above all these great realizations, it is time for humanity to recognize that the solution for the global unbalanced and conflicts, is when we recognize that we are all one family under a common parent, who is God. The Divine Being, who is behind our enlightenment to aspire for ONE FAMILY UNDER GOD. In this sense, we are heading toward a New Civilization, which is different from the old one. This is a God-centered civilization, and as such, it must be anchored on the Principles and Leadership of True Love and Service, Truth, Righteousness, and Goodness.

Concerned and righteous professionals from different fields must lead, support, and propagate the creation of this new civilization by rendering their excellent professional services. In their own respective best, they must guide the creation of this peaceful, harmonious, prosperous, progressive golden civilization of God and humanity, ending all the depressing impact of the selfish civilization that we thrived in this age.

THE CLARION CALL

To ensure the progress of the New Civilization of One Family Under God, **we must usher our young people to become the owners of this new civilization.**

Therefore, this conference of professionals and youth leaders will bind them to work together in making a deeper understanding of what is coming, and what we need to prepare and do, to succeed in welcoming this new age.

The conferences and the main event will highlight young people's capacity to welcome the new civilization.

Though, the setting will be led and organized by professionals, the subject of the events are young people. The conferences of the different fields will showcase the thoughts of both the professionals and the youth leaders. More or less 50% of the speakers are professionals of different disciplines and the rest will come from the youth sector.



Taking into consideration the significant role of the youth in the New Civilization, the highlight of the convention is centered on them through the Bayanihan Youth Festival at the Cuneta Astrodome on August 9, 2023, at 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon with 5,000 youth participating.

THE CONCEPT OF BAYANIHAN

The word Bayanihan is a unique and beautiful Filipino word with no direct translation or equivalent word in English or other languages. It depicts an action, or a movement of people united in spirit with a common aspiration and direction for the tribe, community, nation, world, or a higher cause. There is no existing official record as to when it began but believed to be innate among the Filipinos from its beginning.

It is a combination of 2 root words, "bayan" which means nation, and "anihan" which means harvest time or a season to harvest. "Anihan" comes from the root word "ani", which means fruit or harvest. And in this season of harvest, thanksgiving to God through working together as a community to harvest God's bounty and feasting, are among the common practices of the early folks.

Bayanihan is a consciousness, which naturally inclines Filipinos to the idea that we are all from God, and humanity is one big family. With this indigenous heart, Filipinos unconsciously draw their purpose to serve anywhere in the world.

Bayanihan binds Filipinos anywhere in the world. They find comfort and security in each other. They draw strength and the value of serving other nationalities.

The "Bayanihan spirit" is the soul of the Filipino people, the consciousness that makes us aware that we are all brothers and sisters, under God's parenthood, and that we are a family. It is the spirit that makes Filipinos flexible in adapting to the world's different cultures.

The Bayanihan spirit naturally binds the Filipinos in the old times, to voluntarily help till the land of their neighbors, and plant seeds for a good harvest, for the good of the community, to overcome the dry and wet seasons. And it is the same spirit that draws the folks to harvest together. And celebrate later as one big family, in thanksgiving to God.

Bayanihan was used, when men in the old times come together to carry a nipa hut (house made of bamboo and coconut leaves) to transfer it to another place, nearby the field, which the house owner tills. It is a picture of unity, camaraderie, and service.

Bayanihan was used during the post-war when the country was destroyed by foreign invaders. Filipinos united by giving their free services and contributing their wealth to rebuild the nation.

Bayanihan is the magic word, when a call for volunteers is needed, to rescue and save lives in times of calamities caused by typhoons, floods, earthquakes, volcanic eruptions, landslides, pandemics, and others. It is also the word used, in restoring the community after the calamity.

Through Bayanihan, people will come together, old, and young to protect their community in anticipation of a coming risk or danger. People of different ages would work together to make a long pile of sandbags to prevent a mudflow from hitting their village.

Through the Bayanihan spirit, it is innate among Filipinos to be hospitable to their guests, especially to foreigners.



Bayanihan is a God-centered word, which combines all the following words: sacrificial love, heroism, loyalty, fellowship, filial piety, friendship, righteousness, patriotism, service, courage, camaraderie, unity, living for the greater good, humility, leadership, selflessness, initiative, responsible, accountable, etc.

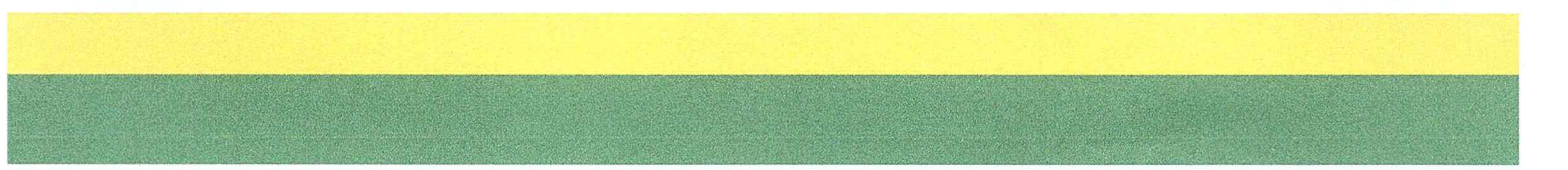
