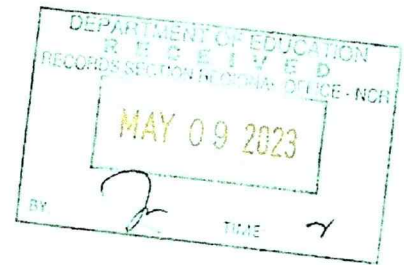

EASTWEST RURAL BANK I RESPECT Award 2023

AWARD RATIONALE

The EWRB "I Respect" Award is given to **FIVE (5)** graduating Grade 6 students from each DepEd Region who exemplifies the value of respect, a core value of EWRB, in his/her day-to-day dealings and encounter. Respect, as a value, can be expressed through actions such as, but not limited to:

1. **RESPECT to Oneself** by taking care of oneself, physically, mentally, and emotionally.
2. **RESPECT to Others** by being courteous and polite when talking to teachers, classmates and the elderly. Treats everyone equally and accepts that each one is unique and different.
3. **RESPECT to Culture & Religion** by having a good relationship with people of different faiths and beliefs and does not misrepresent or belittle their beliefs and practices.
4. **RESPECT for the Environment** by being responsible for his/her actions towards the surroundings.
5. **RESPECT to Social Media** by being responsible in using social media platform and respecting others online.

The awardee shall receive EWRB I Respect medallion and a cash incentive amounting to Php5,000.00.

OBJECTIVES

The "I Respect Award" campaign aims to recognize the efforts of the Teachers to mold their student's values in their day-to-day dealings and encounters. Specifically, this project aims to:

1. Convey a message that EWRB places high regards to the students' value of respect towards humanity, the environment, social, cultural, and spiritual beliefs.
2. Show the Bank's desire to uphold respect as a value amidst the current social issue of students' disrespect towards their teachers.
3. Maintain the Bank's relationship with the key DepED officers through participation in one of its major activities – the Graduation Rites.

WHO CAN JOIN?

The EWRB "I Respect Award" is open to **ALL DepEd Elementary Schools**. Each region, through the Regional Head, is invited to nominate **TEN (10) schools** from which the qualifiers will be taken. Strictly one (1) candidate is allowed per school.

Five (5) nominees from each region will be selected by the Bank as recipient of the award.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA FOR AWARD RECIPIENT

1. Bona fide graduating Grade 6 elementary student at the current School Year 2022-2023.
2. Of good moral character and does not have any record or report of any inappropriate behavior or misconduct
3. GWA: No minimum general average is required to qualify as recipient of the award.

SELECTION PROCESS AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARDEES

1. A **PRE-SCREENING** of all submissions will be conducted for compliance. Submissions with lacking documents will automatically be disqualified.

2. Nominees from each region shall undergo **JUDGING PROCESS** to select the **FIVE (5)** awardees out of ten (10) nominees from each region based on the criteria below:
 - I. Overall Ranking based on the I Respect Scorecard
 - II. The Impact of the described situation/event where/when the nominee was observed to have exercised the value of **RESPECT**, as illustrated by the advisor/teacher.
3. The selected 5 nominees from each region shall be the "I Respect" award recipients for the area.
4. A letter will be sent to the Regional Office and school addressed to the School Principal to inform them of the selection of their nominees as award recipients.
5. East West Rural Bank reserves the right not to award, and to withdraw and/or forfeit any of the award should the participants or entries fail to meet a certain competition requirement

AWARD

1. The selected award recipient/s will receive the following:
 - I. EWRB I Respect Medallion
 - II. Cash Incentive amounting to Php5,000.00
2. The award will be turned over by EWRB representative to the School Principal before the ceremony for their preparations.

AWARD PRESENTATION

1. The award shall be presented to the selected recipient during the Graduation of the school under the Special Awards Category.
2. EWRB representative shall accompany the school officials during the presentation of the award to the student recipient.
