CONCEPT PAPER FOR MATHEMATICS TEACHERS SEMINAR WORKSHOP ON CONTENT AND PEDAGOGY

Program Title: MATHEMATICS TEACHERS SEMINAR WORKSHOP ON CONTENT AND

PEDAGOGY

Date : August 12-14, 2023

Organizers: Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines, Inc.

Background of the Program:

The Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines, Inc. will conduct a three-day seminar workshop for elementary , junior and senior high school Math teachers on content and pedagogy. The first two days will be face to face while the third day will be online via zoom and the focus will be Lesson Study. On the first two days, there will be four sessions. Each session will start with the discussions on how conceptual teaching is done in Mathematics. Then the rest of the time will be spent on exploring and solving different problems in mathematics, routine and non-routine.

The Teachers Seminar – Worskhop and Convention has been a regular program of MTAP for several years except this Pandemic period. The program has been participated by different schools and divisions in the regions. The program is an avenue for teachers to enhance their mathematical skills, problem solving and critical thinking skills.

Objectives:

- 1. Strengthen knowledge and skills towards improving teachers' teaching in Mathematics
- 2. Equip teachers with deeper knowledge of Conceptual Math
- 3. Provide teachers opportunities to understand Lesson Study and make it as a regular program in their workplace

On the third day, there will be two types of audience:

- i. **Zoom attendees will be composed of 30-35 MTAP Facilitators** per room from grade levels. In principle, they will be the direct audience of the speaker where they can interact with the speaker where they can ask or answer questions.
- ii. **Facebook live attendees Non-Zoom attendees** may view and participate in the seminar through the Facebook live stream.

Training Schedule:

The seminar - workshop will be composed of six (6) sessions with four (4) sessions face to face that will be held in Mataas na Paaralang Neptali A. Gonzales, Schools Division of Mandaluyong City, from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The last two sessions will be via zoom platform. The link will be given to the participants upon registration.

The program is open to all grade school, junior high school and senior high school teachers who are interested in enhancing their teaching skills in Mathematics. All interested participants are required to register only once for the program. The registration fee is eight hundred pesos (800.00) for the three days seminar workshop. The registration will be done by the assigned division coordinator. To be registered the participating teachers must present proof of payment to the coordinator. The teacher will receive his/her room number for the sessions.
