The Break the Fake Movement (BTFM) is a local non-government organization that implements a media and information literacy (MIL) strategy and supports UNESCO's efforts in enabling MIL competencies across the Southeast Asian region through leadership development and different initiatives. These initiatives include creating fact-checking programs and resources to strengthen the critical-thinking capabilities of Filipino citizens, developing a new breed of responsible digital citizens through development programs, competitions, and training and workshops, and building a community founded on positive participation.

For over six years, BTFM has collaborated with various local and international MIL-related organizations to fulfill its mission continually. Recently, BTFM partnered with Internews to create the **Media Civics Lab Fact-Checking Academy**.
