- l. Must be physically and mentally fit
- m. Must be a holder of a valid passport (valid for at least 6 months from the date of travel)
- Should not have, in principle, stayed in Japan

- Nomination Letter from the Regional/Bureau Director or his/her duly authorized representative (thru the Regional HRDD Chiefs) **(as applicable only)
- Nomination Letter from Bureau/Office Director or his/her designated signing authority**(for Central Office applicants)

Applications may be disqualified due to various reasons such as but not limited to incomplete requirements, unsigned endorsement/s, application was sent directly through the secretariat's email, discrepancy in documents, etc.

JICA, the sponsoring institution, shall screen and select the participants to this training based on the submitted documents of all applicants. Results will be coordinated with the NEAP Scholarship Secretariat not later than July 7, 2023.
