

SUBJECT: INVITATION TO THE 1ST DEPED NATIONAL MONITORING

AND EVALUATION (M&E) CONFERENCE 2023

DATE : 22 May 2023

Consistent with the institutionalization of the Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework (BEMEF) in the Department of Education (DepEd) and in support to the Basic Education Development Plan (BEDP) and MATATAG Agenda, the Planning Service-Policy Research and Development Division (PS-PRDD) will conduct the Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Conference with DepEd technical personnel involved in the M&E activities in their respective divisions/units from the Central Office, Regions and Schools Division Offices. The M&E conference aims to support the implementation of BEMEF. Specifically, it aims to: (a) Set the direction of DepEd's M&E system; (b) Provide updates on the global and national M&E practices; (c) Discuss the principles and standards of M&E; (d) Discuss the M&E strategies and mechanisms of DepEd (e.g., BEIS, LIS, PMIS) as mechanisms of doing M&E in DepEd; and (d) Promote cooperation among DepEd program managers and staff to support M&E initiatives across governance levels. It will serve as a platform for dialogue on how the community of practice could fully support the implementation of the MATATAG Agenda. It will allow the participants to gain insights and learnings on M&E concepts. approaches and strategies to be discussed in the conference sessions.

The M&E Conference will be held in-person from 19-23 June 2023 (including travel dates) at REGION XII (final venue will be announced later) with the theme, "M&E For Improved Basic Education Governance". Expected participants are the following:
