As you may know, the Course on Japan for High School Classroom Instructions (CJH) Team provides Pedagogy Seminars twice a year, in July and in November, for all CJH teachers with the aim of improving their Japanese and their Japanese language teaching skills, strengthening the CJH teacher community, and providing opportunities to gain experience from each other.
