The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) serves as the focal office for the implementation of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) program in the Department of Education (DepEd)¹. As mandated by DepEd Order No. 47 s. 2021, titled Creation of the Bureau of Alternative Education in the Department of Education, one of BAE's functions is to lead the development and management of ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC)- related activities, in coordination with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD).

Consistent with the Department of Education's MATATAG Agenda which focuses on making the curriculum relevant to produce competent and job ready, active and responsible citizens, the formal education K to 10 Curriculum was revised. Part of the policy action is to align the curriculum of both formal and non-formal education targeting competencies to prepare learners for life, work, and sustainable development.

Being a parallel learning system provides a viable alternative to formal education instruction, it is important that the ALS K to 10 BEC remain relevant and aligned with the formal Curriculum (Revised K to 10 Curriculum).

In this connection, the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in coordination with BCD will conduct the **Writeshop on the Review and Alignment of Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Curriculum vis-a-vis the Revised K to 10 Curriculum** from July 17 to 21, 2023 in City State Asturias Hotel, South National Highway, Tinguiban Heights, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

This activity aims to:

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1. Acquaint the participants with the Revised K to 10 Curriculum of the formal system;
2. Review the revised K to 10 curriculum of the formal system considering the nature of ALS learning delivery;
3. Align the ALS K to 10 BEC vis-a-vis the Revised K to 10 Curriculum of the formal system; and
4. Identify competencies to be included in the ALS K to 10 BEC based on the Revised K to 10 Curriculum of the formal system.

Please see Attachment No. 1 for the List of Participants and Attachment No. 2 for the Indicative Program of Activities. Participants are required to bring their own laptops, extension cords, and other related reading materials. Participants are requested to comply with all COVID-19 Alert Level System protocols set by the national and local Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Infectious Diseases (IATF), as well as the most recent DepEd rules and/or policies on non-disruption of classes.

Board and lodging, and other expenses for supplies and materials will be charged to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 FLO-ALS Current Fund, while travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants for this activity will be charged to the comprehensively released fund, identified in Memorandum Number OASALS-OM-2023-015, titled, Fiscal Year 2023 Alternative Learning System Funds Directly Released to the Regional Offices. All related expenses will be subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Regional ALS Focal Persons are advised to facilitate the most convenient means of reimbursement of expenses of the participants for this activity. Downloading of funds to the respective Schools Division of the participants is highly encouraged, when deemed necessary and applicable.

In case the downloaded funds are not sufficient to cover the actual expenses incurred, Program Support Fund (PSF) FY 2023 or local funds will be utilized to augment the reimbursement of the said expenses.
