The Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), with technical assistance from the USAID Improving Learning Outcomes in the Philippines (ILO-Ph)¹ is working to produce deeper analyses of the results of the National Achievement Tests (NATs) for Grade 6 (2018 and 2022), Grade 10 (2018 and 2020), Grade 12 (2019) and the Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy Assessment (ELLNA, 2018 and 2022). The first workshop on Data Analysis took place last July 3-7, 2023.

A follow-up workshop on **Strategic Communications (StratComms)** will take place from July 18 to 21, 2023 at SEAMEO INNOTECH, Quezon City. The workshop,
