According to the complaint, the learner was not allowed to graduate for non-compliance with his On-the-Job Training due to his mental health conditions.

- 1) I just want to inquire on the current status of Wise Kids School of Muntinlupa located in Block 7, Lot 68, Dollar St., Villa Carolina Tunasan Muntinlupa Metro Manila.
- 2.) I just want to ask if all the private schools had a mandatory OJT (On the job training) for G12 Senior High School?
- 3) My son cannot comply on his OJT because of his sudden changes on his health condition, he is currently under medication and diagnose with Anxiety with OCPD and Depression. I informed the school on this but unfortunately, **lack of support and they won't allow my son to be included on the list of Graduates this coming Graduation day on the last week of May. They insisted on the completion of OJT without consideration on the mental health condition of my Son.**

I know this will bring a negative impact on my son and for the whole family. As a parent I am hoping for his recovery and for his bright future as well.
