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Appendix B

Commitment Form

I, _____ (Name), _____ (Designation), of _____ (School, Division, and Region), and the Department of Education, in consideration of the authority for me to avail of the training courses of the Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL) delivered by the program partner of DepEd for SPFL, do hereby agree to the following terms:

1. That I shall keep with the necessary standards and requirements of the training;
2. That I shall conduct myself in a manner so as not to bring disgrace or dishonor to myself and/or my school;
3. That I shall serve the school where I am presently assigned for at least 3 school years to:
 - a) Teach the foreign language under the SPFL implemented by the school;
 - b) Develop and implement other programs/projects relative to learning/teaching the foreign language;
 - c) Train another teacher from the same school who is willing to handle SPFL classes in the future on my 2nd year of handling SPFL classes.
4. That I shall refund in full, by salary deduction the training expenses, travel allowances, and other benefits including stipend (when applicable) provided by the Department of Education and the SPFL program partner, in case of my failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions through my fault or willful neglect, resignation, request for transfer or other causes within my control, it being understood that proportionate refund shall in no case be allowed.
5. In the event of a granted request for transfer, I, the SPFL teacher shall ensure and make necessary arrangements with the school head in order that the program will be offered to the school to where I will transfer.
6. That I shall submit a completion report to the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD), through the DepEd Regional Office, Schools Division Office, and my school, upon completion of the training program and my return to duty together with the required documents for reimbursement expenses;
7. That I shall live up to the terms and conditions of this training grant and shall conduct myself appropriately as befitting a teacher as well as a DepEd employee following the CODE OF ETHICS FOR PROFESSIONAL TEACHERS.
