

#### **Greetings!**

FDM Vision Care Research and Training Institute would like to Adopt 1 School for the Vision Care services in your city. The cluster will be part of our eye health services to help learners with visual dysfunctions that affects learning.

A recent study of National University, College of Optometry and Health Science on the "Impact of Digital Online Studies on the Eyes and Brain" revealed that most of our learners engaged in digital near work activities are suffering from eyestrain, headaches, dizziness, and vertigo. Those learners who experience spasmodic blurring of vision at far and near feel their eyes seem to deviate inward or outward. Some learners after prolonged digital exposure complaint of irritated red eyes, dry eyes, seeing black spots, and trouble sleeping. The increasing incidence of myopia has been observed too and immediate measures must be implemented to control and prevent its progression. To address this concern, we shall be providing vision care services among selected. Junior High School learners to prevent the increasing incidence of myopia. The criteria for selection of 50 learners are summarized:

- 1. Accomplished a survey form to determine the learner vision condition https://forms.gle/Yx5HGhJ6PAd5tg5KA
- 2. Visual Acuity for both eyes 20/70 worst shall be provided eye examination and eyeglasses
- 3. Learners with digital eyestrain will be provided early intervention program to assure clear and comfortable vision at far and near.
- 4. Learners with ocular anomalies and visual dysfunctions shall be referred to specialists for appropriate management.
