➤ **QUALIFICATION OF THE PARTICIPANTS**

- Must be registered as a Junior/Senior/Cadet Girl Scout
- Must be physically fit and alert
- Must have earned at least one badge each under the 8-Point Challenge
- Must have attended a troop/patrol/council/regional camp prior to this camp.
- Must be fully vaccinated

➤ **PARTICIPANTS:**

2 - Patrol of Junior Girl Scouts + 2 Troop Leaders  
2 – Patrols of Senior Girl Scouts or more  
*Note: 8 girls per patrol*

➤ **ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE**

Participants are advised to go on their own to and from CLR PTC in Bamban, Tarlac. They are expected to arrive on September 22, 2023 (Friday) at around 4:00 PM for the Triage, registration, settling down, and camp development. The Orientation and Opening Ceremony will be on the following day, September 23, 2023. Participants are expected to leave on September 24, 2023 (Sunday) after lunch.

➤ **EVENT FEE:**

The event fee is Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) per participant to cover food, accommodation, program materials, souvenirs, badges, and activities.



➤ **COVID-19 HEALTH DECLARATION AND LIABILITY WAIVER HEALTH EXAMINATION FORM**

Participants need to submit the accomplished COVID-19 Health Declaration and Liability Waiver and the Health Examination Form (please see attachments) during the on-site registration at CLR PTC (Covered Court) in Bamban, Tarlac on September 22, 2023.

**Important!**

The participant who manifests any of the COVID-19 symptoms shall be subjected to Antigen Test. If the result is Positive, she will be required to go home on her own and will be entitled to the reimbursement of only half of the registration fee. Isolation of participants manifesting symptoms but tested negative shall be at the discretion of the event organizers who will carefully assess the situation. Concerned participants are enjoined to cooperate.
