VALIDATION OF THE FY 2024 REGIONAL ALLOCATION OF THE

SPECIAL HARDSHIP ALLOWANCE

This refers to DepEd Order No. 17, s. 2023 entitled "Amendment to DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2021 (Guidelines on the Provision of Special Hardship Allowance for Public School Teachers)" issued on 19 July 2023. The same lowered the Hardship Index to 0.33, and thereby expanding the coverage of hardship post schools (see Revised Annex A of DO 17). Consequently, the number of eligible teachers who may claim the Special Hardship Allowance (SHA) increased.

In view thereof, the Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development-School Effectiveness Division prepared the FY 2024 regional allocation of the grant of SHA. In order to ensure inclusion of all eligible teachers, all concerned Finance Officers in the field are enjoined to validate the regional allocation on or before 11 September 2023.
