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

This consultative conference specifically aims to:

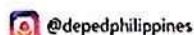
- a) discuss the latest trends, challenges, opportunities, and pertinent issues concerning the curriculum for learners with severe to profound disabilities;
