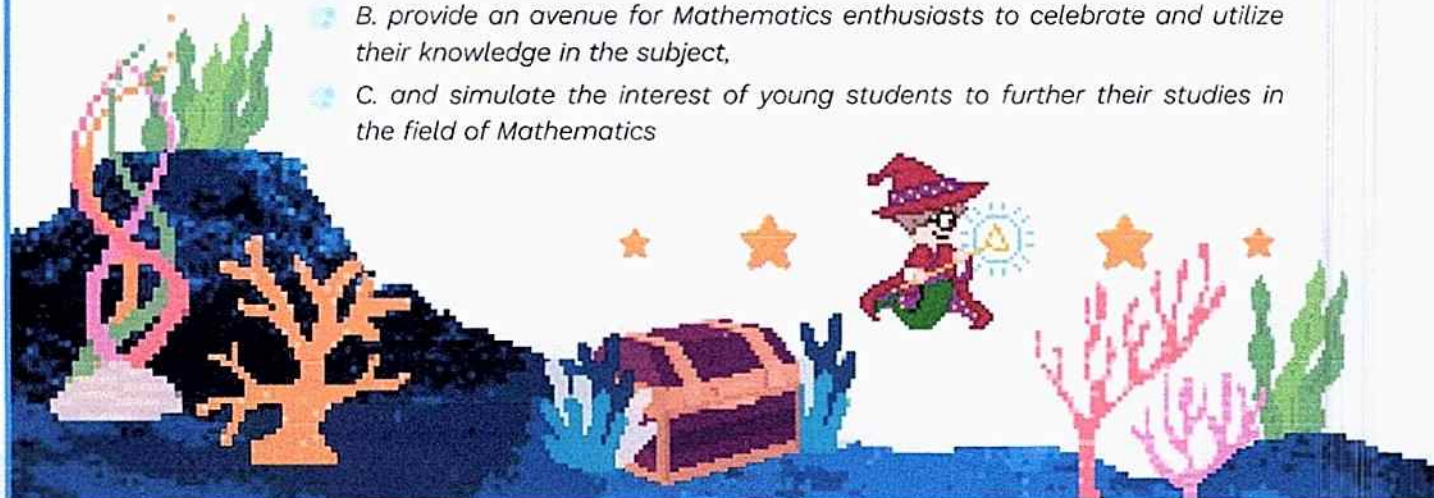
About

The 11th Annual Nationwide Search for the Little Math Wizard is one of the country's most prestigious Mathematics competitions for Grades 4, 5, and 6 learners across all DepEd-recognized schools in the Philippines. The University of the Philippines Mathematics Club (UP Mathematics Club), a non-stock, non-profit, student-run academic organization duly recognized by the University of the Philippines Diliman (UP Diliman), implements the 11th LMW with the endorsement of Institute of Mathematics, UP Diliman and the advisory of Department of Education (DepEd).

Objectives

The University of the Philippines Mathematics Club, the premier student organization for Math enthusiasts across the Philippines, is committed to the advancement of mathematics across its diverse disciplines. With that, the 11th Little Math Wizard aims to:

- 1. A. contribute in the promotion and appreciation of mathematics in its various fields among students and teachers through healthy competition,
- 2. B. provide an avenue for Mathematics enthusiasts to celebrate and utilize their knowledge in the subject,
- 3. C. and simulate the interest of young students to further their studies in the field of Mathematics





REGISTRATION DETAILS

Early bird and regular registration

1. The early bird registration period will start **from Sep 9, 2023 (Saturday) until Oct 9, 2023 (Monday)**.
2. The deadline for regular registration is **October 31, 2023 (Tuesday)**; Any registrations submitted after the aforementioned date will be considered only on the day of the event. Please take note that only those who manage to register and make payment on or before October 9, 2023 (Monday) will see their schools, coaches, and students' names included in the event's souvenir program.
3. Pay the registration fee through either of these payment channels:

4. All paid registration fees are non-refundable.
5. Complete the **LMW2023 Google Registration Form** (<https://forms.gle/qzVPiSVZctvfxkLV6>) by providing all required information. Ensure that the details you enter are clear and comprehensive. After filling out the form, remember to attach a copy of the payment receipt at the end. Please note that the UP Mathematics Club will not reissue certificates with mistakes unless the error is on our part.
6. **For the coaches:** You must get a confirmation text/email from us within 3 days after completing the Google Registration Form and submitting all required documents. If you don't receive a confirmation from us, it means we haven't received your response, and your participants are not yet officially registered. 7. **For the participants:** Make sure to bring your school ID, registration form, enrollment form, or any other documents that prove your enrollment on the day of the competition.

Walk-in Registration

1. When the event day arrives, you'll need to complete an online form requiring essential information.
2. Remember to bring your registration fee and either your school ID, registration form, enrollment form, or any other documents that show you're enrolled.

General registration qualifications

- Each school must send **at least two (2) students** as their official contestants: **at least one (1) from Grade 4 or Grade 5, and at least one (1) from Grade 6.** However, each school can only send a **maximum of twenty (20) contestants only.**
- All immediate relatives of the members and applicants of the UP Mathematics Club are **disqualified** from joining the competition.



GENERAL RULES

1. The contest shall be divided into two (2) stages: the *Elimination Stage* and the *Finals Stage*.
2. The official competition date will be on **November 11, 2023 (Saturday)**. Both *Elimination Stage* and *Finals Stage* shall be held on such date.
3. Registration will officially start at **7:00 AM**, on the day of the competition. The *Elimination Stage* shall start at exactly **9:00 AM** while the *Finals Stage* shall start at **1:00 PM** of the same day. Contestants are highly encouraged to finish registering at least 10 minutes before the start of the *Elimination Stage*.
4. Late registration may still be allowed, provided that contestants satisfy the above qualifications and that the *Elimination Stage* has not yet ended. No time extensions shall be provided for late registrants.
5. The official competition venues shall be as follows:
 - *Elimination Stage* - Institute of Mathematics, UP Diliman
 - *Finals Stage* - PHIVOLCS Auditorium, UP Diliman
6. The coverage of the competition shall include the following mathematical concepts: Algebra, Geometry, Number Theory, Logic, and Probability.
7. The entire competition shall be conducted in English.
8. Any verified violation of any of these rules shall be enough reason for any contestant's disqualification.
9. The Academics Affairs Committee of the UP Mathematics Club, with the concurrence of the Board of Judges, holds full rights to interpret, modify, or change the rules and regulations of the contest, in any case that it is necessary. Decisions involving modification and changing of the rules shall be binding and considered valid.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Any bonafide **Grade 4, Grade 5, or Grade 6** student of any DepEd-recognized elementary school operating in the Philippines is qualified to join the competition. All registrants will be collectively known as 'contestants' for the purposes of this competition. As such, no distinction will be made based on the grade level of the participating students.
2. Contestants shall compete individually and no teams shall be formed at any point during the competition.
3. All contestants must be accompanied by at least **one (1) coach** on the day of the competition. The UP Mathematics Club shall only conduct official business and address registration concerns with these assigned coaches.
4. The school of any participating contestant may send a **maximum of twenty (20) contestants only**. Every participating school must send at least two (2) students as their official contestants: at least one (1) student from Grade 4 or Grade 5 and at least one (1) student from Grade 6.
5. A certification attesting to the contestants' grade levels, signed by the Principal or any duly recognized school representative, stamped with respective school dry seal, and their school IDs shall be required.
6. All immediate relatives of the members and applicants of the UP Mathematics Club shall be disqualified from joining the competition.
7. No protests regarding the qualifications of any of the registered contestants shall be entertained after the *Elimination Stage* has started.
8. If a contestant is found to be in violation at any point before or during the contest proper, the UP Mathematics Club shall have full discretion to forbid or allow any student from participating.
