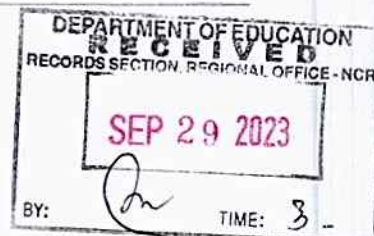



All the Public and Private School Libraries are encouraged to join and spearhead in selecting students to join and participate in the nationwide LISM activities to promote and support its goals.

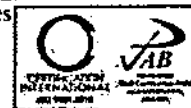
