



FOR LAST MILE SCHOOLS IN COVID-19 PROJECT

This is to relay for consideration the invitation letter sent by NIRAS dated September 29, 2023 (Attachment 1), inviting DepEd National Capital Region (NCR) Officials as participants in the Knowledge Sharing Event for the EdTech Solutions for Last Mile Schools (LMSs) in COVID-19 project. This event to be held on October 12, 2023 was organized by NIRAS, the implementing partner of the project. The venue for the event will be in Joy Nostalg Hotel and Suites, 7 ADB Ave, Ortigas Center (Topaz Road Entrance) Pasig, Metro Manila.

As part of the commitment to inclusivity and to ensure a diverse range of perspectives, two seats per selected school are reserved from each SDOs, preferably School Head and or ICT coordinator to participate as guest participants in this event. Kindly select and nominate two schools from your division that are believed would benefit more from and contribute to this knowledge-sharing endeavor. The selected schools will be allocated two reserved seats each. In line with this, the invitation is particularly extending to Culiat High School, the SEAMEO INNOTECH adopted school in Quezon City, as requested by NIRAS. Moreover, the provision of names of the selected schools and their respective representatives on October 6, 2023, Friday will be highly appreciated.

### I. PROJECT / AGENDA BACKGROUND

1. The EdTech Solutions for Last Mile Schools in COVID-19 is a grant project from the Asian Development Bank (ADB). This project was conceptualized in 2020 to support the operationalization of the Basic Education - Learning Continuity Plan by providing access to facilities and resources that will enable students to continue learning through distance education amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. It also covers the provision of capacity building and learning resources for schools and teachers to aid them in teaching delivery under technology-enabled blended learning modalities.

The project was implemented in four Schools Division Offices (SDOs), namely: Abra, Bohol, Kalinga, and Zamboanga Sibugay. It has developed, reviewed, and delivered 217 Digitized Learning Materials (DLMs) to the 21 secondary last mile schools used for distance and face-to-face learning modality which are accessible via the Moodle platform. Additionally, fifty-four DLMs in Senior High School (SHS) are undergoing production and are slated to be handed over to DepEd Central Office by the end of August 2023.

- 2. Through this undertaking, teachers, Information and Communications Technology coordinators, and school heads of the treatment schools were capacitated on how to foster a more learner-centered classroom environment using technology-enabled resources. Moreover, the participants were introduced to the basics of creating digitized learning material in Moodle.
- 3. Before the project concludes on November 31, 2023, the conduct of this knowledge sharing event aims to celebrate the LMS EdTech Solutions Project's successes, and to disseminate lessons learnt from the implementation of this project.

- 4. The specific objectives of this event are as follows:
  - a. Provide opportunities to LMS teachers to share their experiences;
  - b. Publicize the achievements of online learning in remote locations, serving as a symbol of DepEd's recognition of the difficulties the LMS and their communities face;
  - c. Recognize participating educators (both teachers and school leaders) for their professional development and commitment to the project; and
  - d. Provide perspectives from communities to support and inform future replication.
- 5. The event will also be a venue to raise awareness and may contribute to the better understanding of DLM and the pedagogical framework. Moreover, select stakeholders from outside of the pilot schools and region will be invited to share possible scale-up options through discussion of the Sustainability Plan and current trends and issues on the use of digital learning in education.
