COMPONENTS OF THE BASIC EDUCATION FACILITIES  
FUND AND LAST MILE SCHOOLS PROGRAM

**DATE :** October 3, 2023

The National Expenditure Program (NEP) was already submitted by the Office of the President through the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) to the Congress and Senate for deliberation. Under the NEP, a total of **Php33.756Billion** was approved for the Basic Education Facilities Fund (BEFF) of which, the Education Facilities Division, after its thorough review and evaluation, has determined that a total of **Php 3.616 Billion** out of the total NEP Budget for BEFF CY 2024 are ready for implementation and therefore may already be subjected for Early Procurement Activities (EPA). In the case of the Last Mile Schools Program is **Php 2.968 Billion**.

In accordance with **Rule II. Procurement Planning Section 7.1 of RA9184 (Government Procurement Act)** states that "All procurement shall be within the approved budget of the Procuring Entity and should be meticulously and judiciously planned by the Procuring Entity. Consistent with government fiscal discipline measures, only those considered crucial to the efficient discharge of governmental functions shall be included in the Annual Procurement Plan (APP)".

Likewise, **Rule II. Procurement Planning Section 7.6 of RA9184** states that "To facilitate the immediate implementation of procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects or Consulting Services, even pending approval of the GAA, corporate budget or appropriations ordinance, as the case may be, and notwithstanding Section 7.2 hereof, the **Procuring Entity may undertake the procurement activities short of award**. NGAs, SUCs, Constitutional Commissions or Offices are encouraged to **start their procurement activities immediately after the National Expenditure Program (NEP) has been submitted by the President to Congress, provided that the HoPE has approved the corresponding indicative APP**. This will facilitate the awarding of procurement contracts after the enactment of the GAA, enabling the timely implementation and completion of programs and projects."



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In consideration of the foregoing, the Regional and Division Offices are hereby advised to proceed with the conduct of Early Procurement Activities (EPA) for the following projects with details:
