- 4. Each team shall be composed of 10 learners preferably YES-O officers with 1 trainer. The team shall have their YES-O ID for proper identification.
- 5. Each team shall have protective gears such as gloves, goggles, apron and others alike based on the nature of the tasks that require the use of these gears.
- 6. Each team shall bring tools or materials and other related equipment needed to set up their eco-space
- 7. For documentation purposes, each team shall submit a soft and hard copy (A4 size) of the design lay-out and brief description of the advocacy eco-space to be submitted on the day of the activity.
- 8. During the judging, a representative of the team shall be given a maximum of 5minutes for short interview
- 9. The decision of the board of judges shall be final and irrevocable.
- The 1st Place will receive Php 15,000.00, 2nd place is Php 10,000.00 and 3rd place is 5,000.00.
- 11. Participants are the YES-O students (Maximum of 10 with 2 teacher/trainer per SDO.


