DepEd offers six SCPs in select public (elementary and secondary) schools to help students develop their skills and talents in different areas. These programs show DepEd's commitment to providing high-quality basic education, and the review of SCP Curriculum Guides are in alignment with the recalibration of the MATATAG curriculum.
