The theme for this year, as determined by the CWC will be "Healthy, Nourished, Sheltered: Ensuring the Right to Life for All," highlighting the importance of accessible and quality health care for children, despite the health and economic crises brought about by the pandemic.

With its mandate of facilitating and encouraging all schools nationwide to commemorate the National Children's Month celebration. The Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) shall spearhead the Kick-Off Ceremony on November 11, 2023.
