#### **Event Rationale**

Pursuant to the *Republic Act 11369*, otherwise known as the "*National Students' Day Act*," the National Youth Commission (NYC), the Department of Education (DepEd), and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) are mandated to conduct an annual program of activities that will promote the love of country and social responsibility among the youth and to support the observance of International Students' Day. The celebration shall commemorate the execution of the nine (9) Czechoslovakian students who fought against the Nazi occupation to end the unjust treatment during the time of Adolf Hitler last November 17, 1939.

Looking back at 1896, Filipinos shared the same gallantry story with the Czechoslovakia students, like Dr. Jose Rizal, who advocated peacefully for liberty rather than violent means through his book "Noli Me Tangere" and "El Filibusterismo". Even Andres Bonifacio used his talent in visual arts and craftsmanship in a young age to help his family until he established the "Kataas-taasan, Kagalang-galang na Katipunan ng mga Anak ng Bayan" or "KKK" against the Spanish regime.

For our part, we should develop within ourselves the same fervor Dr. Rizal and Bonifacio had for our contry. Instilling patriotism and nationalism at an early age will inculcate the values of discipline and organization, and will impart common sense to young generation of Filipinos. Everyone has the potential to grow, excel and be the pride of the nation in many different ways.

In support, Article II Section XIII of the 1987 Philippine Constitution hereby states that, "the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs." We believe that students should be given a wide range of opportunities to develop and practice leadership skills and salient talents in preparation for life beyond school. Although there's a long list of leadership activities students can choose to participate in, National Students' Day easily takes first place for it supports one of the DepEd's goal to provide learners a platform where everyone enjoys learning and being creative – trying new things, finding solutions, and embracing their responsibilities. We put the spotlight to our Filipino learners who remain strong and steadfast amidst different challenges.

Thus, the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Operations (OASOPS), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services- Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD), in partnership with the Schools Division Office of Davao del Sur and the National Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government, SY 2023-2024, will conduct the celebration of the **National Students' Day 2023** on **17 November 2023**.

The celebration will capitalize on the learners' diversity and uniqueness that allow them to actively pursue a wide variety of different interests and give them a unique advantage in life. Regardless of who they are and where they come from, they are recognized, valued, and celebrated.

I understand that the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Operations (OASOPS), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services–Learner Formation Division (BLSS-YFD) of the Department of Education shall implement the minimum public health standards set by the government to minimize the risk of the spread of COVID-19, but it cannot guarantee that my child may not be infected with COVID-19 given that it is highly contagious.

### **Exclusion (Limitations/Ineligibility)**

I am aware that symptoms of COVID-19 include, but are not limited to, fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, the new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.

I confirm that my child currently has none of those symptoms, and is in good health. I will not allow my child to physically go to the event if my child or any member of my household develops any of the said symptoms or any other symptoms of illness that may or may not be related to COVID-19. I will also inform the school/division and not allow my child to attend the event if my child or any of my household members tests positive for COVID-19.
