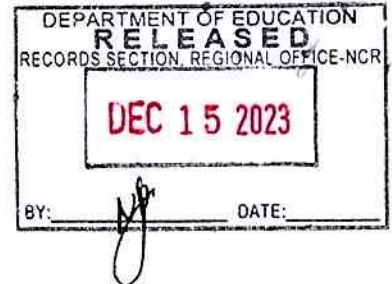

The participants of the youth camp will be 4 students (2 males and 2 females) including 1 teacher to participate through nomination. The nominated school should have a background on SDG goals and has the potential to learn and promote SEP and its linkage with the SDGs. The specific criteria are as follows:

**Students:**

- i. Must be enrolled in high school (Grades 9-11 or ages 15 to 17).
- ii. English language fluency
- iii. Demonstrate a positive attitude and be physically fit to participate in all camp activities
- iv. Have prior exposure or experience in sustainable development initiatives in school or community
- v. Exhibit a genuine interest in contributing to future activities within their school or community
- vi. In cases where parental travel authorization is necessary, nominees should provide the required documentation directly to the nominating government office/agency in the SEAMEO Member Countries

**Teachers:**

- i. Must be a teacher at high school level (Grades 9-11 or ages 15 to 17).
- ii. Have at least 5 years of teaching experience in the nominated school
- iii. English language fluency
- iv. Have prior exposure or experience in sustainable development initiatives in school or community
- v. Exhibit a genuine interest in contributing to future activities within their school or community

At the end of the youth camp, the participants are expected to have an enhanced understanding of SEP and the SDGs as they have a call to action towards sustainable development. As they foster a human-centered approach to problem-solving by developing skills, mindset and tools, they are expected to gain valuable networking opportunities to promote collaboration amongst participants. The participants' outputs are to obtain 11 models for action researches approach through SEPs-based design thinking approaches and exchange common interests in improving problem-solving effectively.

**Financial Implication**

SEAMEO SEPS will shoulder the costs of the country delegation (5 participants) including economy international return air tickets from Bangkok to capital city, accommodation, meals, ground transportation in Thailand, and minimal per diem for incidental costs during travel days at home country.

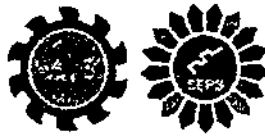

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## **1. Background**

The Sufficiency Economy Philosophy, introduced by His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej over 50 years ago, places strong emphasis on sustainable development, self-reliance, social equity, environmental stewardship, ethical values, cultural preservation, and global relevance. It is fully aligned with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

To ensure that the principles of the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy are effectively transmitted to the younger generation, it has been seamlessly integrated into the Thai basic education curriculum. This integration equips learners with the necessary knowledge and skills to champion sustainable development and adopt sustainable lifestyles. These educational efforts thrive in environments that encourage sufficiency-based sustainability learning and actively support interaction with local communities.

In this context, the SEAMEO Regional Centre for Sufficiency Economy Philosophy for Sustainability (SEAMEO SEPS) is dedicated to organising the Southeast Asia Plus Sustainable Development Goals Youth Camp 2024. This initiative is designed to promote the values and principles of the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy among youth while actively engaging them with the United Nations' SDG goals, fostering a deep understanding of sustainable development and its significance in today's world.

The Southeast Asia Plus Sustainable Development Goals Youth Camp 2024 is a collaborative initiative organised by SEAMEO-SEPS and Suranaree University of Technology (SUT). The Youth Camp brings together experiences of youth and teachers from Thailand and other SEAMEO Member Countries through various activities that would allow discussions and the sharing of experiences aimed at promoting sustainability.

## **2. Objectives**

- b. To ignite a sense of inspiration among the youth in SEAMEO Member Countries, encouraging them to champion the incorporation of SEP into sustainability efforts in their schools and communities
- c. To nurture the skills and mindset necessary for a human-centered approach to problem-solving, using design thinking within the framework of SEP and SDGs
- d. To facilitate valuable networking opportunities among the youth, fostering connections and collaborations
- e. To establish a network of schools for sharing knowledge and best practices on SEP and the SDGs

- b. From networking among youth, teachers and schools in the SEAMEO members, they can share and exchange common interests in improving problem-solving effectively

## **7. Methodology**

The Southeast Asia Plus Sustainable Development Goals Youth Camp 2024 will take place in Nakhon Ratchasima Province, Thailand. The camp will center its attention on the convergence of the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy and the Sustainable Development Goals, with a particular emphasis on the Southeast Asian region, notably the SEAMEO Member Countries.

The Student Entrepreneurship Development Academy of the Suranaree University of Technology will lead the conduct of the youth camp. The design thinking approach will be employed to generate innovative solutions for a spectrum of design problems. This method underscores the significance of employing empathy to identify human-centered solutions. Students will be exposed to other skills such as problem-solving, collaboration, and creativity. Meanwhile, teachers will obtain insights on various activities that could be useful in teaching and learning processes.
