

In view of this, the Philippine Normal University-Research Center for Teacher Quality (PNU-RCTQ) together with the Philippine Institute for Development Studies (PIDS) and USAID ABC+, shall conduct fieldwork in the pilot schools of the MATATAG Curriculum, specifically in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 4, and 7 in Regions I, II, VII, XII, the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), CARAGA, and the National Capital Region (NCR) for School Year (SY) 2023-2024.

The fieldwork aims to gather data through the observation of classes and collaborative expertise sessions along with interviews and focus group discussions, with teachers and school heads. It shall provide empirical evidence on the understanding of teachers and school heads about the new curriculum and its different components and designs along with the identification of various concerns, support, and resources needed for appropriate and effective curriculum implementation.


PURPOSE OF FIELDWORK ACTIVITIES

Activity	Purpose		
Interview with school head	Inquire about preparation, challenges, concerns, and insights on the pilot implementation of the MATATAG curriculum.		
Classroom observation with interview	Document the MATATAG curriculum pilot implementation through the utilization of lesson exemplars and student worksheets. Have teachers describe experiences and share perspectives in doing the pilot implementation specifically on the use of Learning Resource Packages which integrate the science of learning and student-focused approach.		
Observation of LAC session	Document the conduct of LAC sessions in the different learning areas with focus on session content, collaboration, planning, implementation, and evaluation.		
Focus Group Discussion	Document the teachers' preparations, practices and challenges encountered related to the pilot implementation MATATAG curriculum.		




