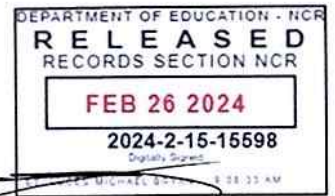



In line with the MATATAG Basic Education Agenda to provide necessary support for teachers to teach better, the Association des Professeurs de Francais aux Philippines (APFP) shall conduct the **Échanges et Découvertes Series: Training-Workshop for Teachers of French in February and March** at the **University of the Philippines Diliman, Alliance Française de Cebu**, and via an **online platform**.

The training-workshop series aims to provide French teachers with new insights and teaching strategies specific to the teaching of French as a foreign language. The trainers come from different teaching contexts in the Philippines and were selected by the French Embassy in the Philippines to attend the International Teachers' Training Program in Francophonie in Nice, France last July 2023.

In addition, recognizing the efforts of the teachers, they are eligible to avail of service credits commensurate to the number of hours/days of the training as scheduled, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*.
