My name is Geoffrey Ijsenbruk, I am a volunteer with the Christ For All Nations Evangelism Alliance Youth Programs. We are an international organization with 15 offices in 12 countries on 6 continents throughout the world. In the last 3 years, our teams have conducted more than 7000 school programs and spoken to well over 3 million students worldwide. We speak to youth in schools about making the right choices in life, to help and guide them find purpose. We share a message of love, hope, peace, joy, forgiveness, purpose, identity and moral values according to Godly principles. Our team has seen a successful launch of speaking with over 130,000 students in 212 schools in Mindanao.

We are requesting to speak to the youth in every school in your district for 15-20 minutes about making right choices in life and making the most important choice in life. We will cover topics like drugs, alcohol, suicidal mindsets, disobedience to parents and teachers, gangs, stealing, cheating, and lying. We will also talk about turning away from these bad things in life and turning to God. We believe when the students are strong spiritually in their relationship with God, they will do even better academically. We do not represent any denomination, but do talk to the students about the need to have a relationship with God. We request to meet with the students in your district for just 15-20 minutes about making these right choices in life.

We ask, if possible please, that you give us permission to visit with your students for 15-20 minutes during the weeks from the 8th through to 26th April 2024. We thank you for your time and consideration, and pray the Lord abundantly bless you.
