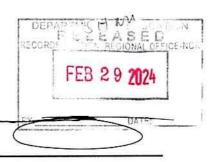

- 1. In adherence to OUOPS Memorandum No. 2023-03-1109 entitled "MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION OF THE GULAYAN SA PAARALAN PROGRAM (GPP)", this office reiterates that the Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP) shall be handled by the School Health Division.
- 2. To ensure the effective implementation of the program, GPP monitoring shall be done using the prescribed Monitoring Tool (Attachment No.1). Frequency of monitoring shall be quarterly for division level and semi-annually for regional level. Schedule of the regional monitoring visits shall be announced in a separate memorandum.
- 3. For recording and reporting, the Division GPP Focal Person shall prepare the consolidated school profiles in their respective divisions using the GPP Form 1 Consolidated shall be uploaded No.2). forms https://bit.ly/GPPForm1 on or before March 22, 2024.
- 4. Further, a Program Terminal Report using GPP Form 2 (Attachment No.3). The consolidated report shall be submitted to the Regional Office on or before June 14, 2024 for consolidation and forwarding to DepEd-BLSS.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this memorandum is desired.

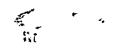
