Participating teachers shall observe the time-on-task policy based on **DepEd No. 9**, s. 2005 titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Tasks and Ensuring Compliance Therewith* to ensure that learning shall not be disrupted and continued for the benefit of the learners. Additionally, their participation shall adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 003 s. 2004 titled Amendment to DepEd

adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2024, titled Amendment to DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2023 (Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024) and DepEd OASGFO Memorandum No. 2022-058 with the subject Request for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-Curricular Activities.

The qualified teachers are likewise eligible to avail of service credits commensurate to the number of hours/days of the training as scheduled, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*.

School heads and supervisors are directed to make the necessary arrangements in the schedules of the teachers should they be chosen to participate in any of the training programs. A separate memorandum on the chosen participants shall be issued by this Office.
