In reference to the DepEd Order (DO) No. 039, s. 2021 entitled "Guidelines on the Provision of Special Hardship Allowance for Public School Teachers" and the list of hardship posts in the DO 017, s. 2023 entitled "Amendment to DepEd Order No. 039, s. 2021 (Guidelines on the Provision of Special Hardship Allowance for Public School Teachers)" which are both valid until FY 2023 only, there is an ongoing joint study between the Department and the United Nation Children's Fund (UNICEF) to come up with a new set of hardship variables to objectively determine hardship posts. The result of the study shall be the basis in the development of the new guidelines for the provision of SHA to eligible teachers starting FY 2024.

With this, the DepEd Regional and Schools Division Offices (ROs and SDOs) are directed to wait for the new guidelines in the provision of SHA for FY 2024. A separate memorandum for the processing of SHA shall be issued immediately upon the issuance of a new DepEd Order.
