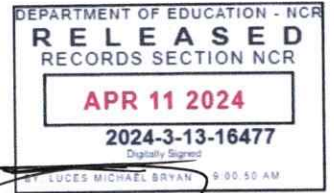

With eager anticipation of a fun-filled day, sporting spirit, and friendly banter, we wish to formally announce the holding of the

FAMILY GAMES AND SPORTS FESTIVAL

at the UA&P Gym, Parking, and Sports Building,
on Saturday, 13 April, from 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

HERE ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT DETAILS

A. SPORTS, GAMES AND CATEGORIES.

The Festival will feature three COMPETITIVE SPORTS and three COMPETITIVE GAMES, with five SPORTS CATEGORIES and three GAMES CATEGORIES

Sports and Categories (for students only)

1. Volleyball Male
2. Volleyball Female
3. Basketball Male
4. Futsal Male
5. Futsal Female

Games (for students, teacher-coaches, and parents)

6. Tug-of-War
7. Sack Race with Cone Flip
8. Kalamansi Relay

B. HOUSES. The participating students with their parents shall be divided into ten HOUSES with corresponding names and colors. In turn, the ten HOUSES shall be distributed between two BRACKETS.

BRACKET A

Archers (Red)
Cannoneers(Orange)
Guardians (Yellow)
Miners (Green)
Knights (Blue)

BRACKET B

Musketeers (Indigo)
Pirates (Violet)
Spartans (Brown)
Titans (White)
Vikings (Grey)

C. SCHOOL PARTICIPATION

1. **DELEGATION AND ENTRIES.** Each ACTIVE CACHET School can send at most 15 CACHET officers, one parent or guardian of each, and three CACHET teacher-coaches, for a total of 19 delegate entries per school. The Registration Form is enclosed.

It is the responsibility of the teacher-coaches to see to it **that no student delegate shall have played in ANY school varsity teams previously.** It is to be noted that the sports, particularly, are in the spirit of family competitions.

Each student entry shall include his or her sports of interest.

The deadline for the school registration form, with names, designation, and sports of interest, is hereby set for noon on Monday, 25 March.

2. **DISTRIBUTION INTO HOUSES.** The CACHET Office shall be responsible for randomly distributing the school delegates into the TEN Houses, distributing the school delegates equitably into the ten Houses.
3. **COLOR DISPLAY AND ATTIRE.** On the Festival Day, each House shall be expected to wear its COLOR in any which way they choose, provided the means shall be obvious to the officers of the games and sports, and provided further that only minimal cost shall be incurred in the color display.

ATTIRE. Sports attire upon entry into the campus, comprising jogging pants and t-shirts. The play attire shall comprise t-shirts and **appropriate** sports shorts.

4. **ZOOM MEET OF HOUSE FOR PLANNING.** Upon announcement of the House compositions, a tentatively CACHET-designated House representative shall be requested to call a Zoom meeting of the teacher-coaches belonging to the House to plan out their participation and their own rubrics and norms for the games and sports competition.

Each House shall designate a HOUSE CAPTAIN, who shall be responsible for fielding players to the corresponding competitions and for managing the House in all matters pertinent to the Festival.

D. GAME MECHANICS

1. The three sports competitions shall have a respective round robin among the five Houses within the bracket, with each game following the duration to be designated by the University PE Department, which shall be responsible too for the scheduling of the sports and gam
2. The mechanics shall be announced separately from this letter once the Houses are organized. Suffice it to say that given the round-robin mode, each game shall be short but deemed enough to determine the “better” House of the moment.

Likewise, games are played simultaneously depending only on the space configuration and limitations of the gym.
