The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) is mandated by RA 11510 and Its IRR to offer Functional Education and Literacy Program (FELP), defined as *"a short-term non-formal education programs designed to help socioeconomically disadvantaged learners to upgrade a targeted set of skills, knowledge and selected competencies in the ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum in order to improve their social, political, and economic well-being and function more effectively as citizens, parents, workers and members of the community"* (Section 6, 6.1). This newly introduced program will expand access to lifelong learning opportunities as it envisions the development of enhanced functional life skills of interested Filipino OSYA learners.

This Bureau wishes to identify the interests of the target ALS learners on the appropriate short-term courses to be offered under FELP through this survey. This initiative will ensure that the directions of BAE are in alignment with and meet the learning needs and demands of the ALS learners.
