## A RESOLUTION FORMALIZING THE REVISIONS ON THE INTERIM GUIDELINES FOR THE LEARNER GOVERNMENT PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the National Federation of the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (NFSSLG), comprised of all the Regional Federation Presidents, serves as the highest governing body for all the public students in the Philippines;
- WHEREAS, the NFSSLG is committed to aid in the empowerment of all public school learner governments established for the guidance and development of the Filipino youth;
- WHEREAS, the NFSSLG, following the assessment of the released OUOPS no. 2023-03 Memorandum or the "Interim Guidelines of the Learner Government Program for 2023-2024," recognizes the gaps that should be addressed to better ensure the inclusivity and equity of every sector stated;
- WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG), as part of the Interim Guidelines, is an important document entailing the fundamental principles, functions, and operations of an organization;
- WHEREAS, the NFSSLG aims to realign the set of guidelines for the learner government program to address the emergence of the following challenges and limitations with reference to the SELG/SSLG Constitution and By-Laws;
- WHEREAS, the NFSSLG acknowledges the prospective enhancement in the formation of the Coordinating Council as stipulated in the Article XII of the aforementioned memorandum;
- WHEREAS, the Coordinating Council will create a common platform for all the existing school organizations to collaborate and provide assistance in implementing projects and activities for learner welfare aligned with the revised Interim Guidelines for the Learner Government Program;





- WHEMEAS, Article NVI of the Constitution and By-Laws introduces the composition of the Division, Ragional, and National Federations of Supreme Secondary Learner Government;
- WHEREAS, emphasizing—the distinction of duties in the committees of the SELG/SSLG and the Coordinating Council, stated in Section 6, Article XU of the same document, is a crucial need to establish a more organized and offective teamer-lod council:
- WHEREAS, the NFSSLG recognizes the need for a specific and comprehensive provision comprehensively stating the functions and procedures that will guide the operation of the said federations:
- WHEREAS, as the leading representative of the student body, the NFSSLG identifies the revalidation and revision of the Interim Gurdelines as pivotal steps in ensuring the success of the leavner government program:

FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND THE RELEASE OF THE NATIONAL ASSESSMENT FORM AS A BASELINE TO STRATEGIC PRIORITIZATION OF EDUCATIONAL REFORMS AND ENHANCEMENTS FOR THE LEARNER BODY

- WHEREAS, the National Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government (NFSSLG) composed of all Regional Federation Presidents, is the highest level of the learner government program under the DepEd's Bureau of Learner -Learner Formation Division.
- WHEREAS, the NFSSLG stands at the forefront of the learners' rights and welfare and is committed to continuously advocate for policies initiatives, and reforms that promote inclusivity, equity, and quality education for all learners;
- **WHEREAS**, the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child states that children have the right to share their thoughts freely;
- WHEREAS, Section 1.7, Article VII of the Interim Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) states that the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) must serve as the representative of the student body in raising their concerns, opinions, and grievances to the concerned individual or units;
- WHEREAS, Section 1.8, Article VI of the same document, supports the responsibility aforementioned in Article VII, where it states that every learner must enjoy the right to have proper representation and the right to be heard concerning his or her welfare and education
- WHEREAS, Section 10, Article IV of the Interim Constitution and Bylaws of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) states that the SSLG shall provide a channel for learners' opinions, suggestions, grievances, and other concerns affecting their rights and welfare in school;





- WHEREAS, the National Assessment form is seen as a crucial trad that will provide an invaluable platform for the NVSSLG to engage the students in gathering the opinions, preferences, and concerns of learners throughout the nation to inform the policies and programs of the federation;
- WHEREAS, the crafting of the Piational Assessment form will be speacheaded by the NFSSLG President, the NFSSLG Addition, and NFSSLG Board Members from Regions 2, 6, and U;
- WHEREAS, the National Assessment Form will go through a validation process to be speacheaded by the NESSLG and the BLSS-Youth Formation Division to ensure accuracy, reliability, and effectivity;
- WHEREAS, the collaborative development of the National Assessment Form underscores NFSSLUs dedication to inclusivity, transparency, and a comprehensive approach to educational evaluation, ensuing that the tool reflects the diverse needs and challenges fixed by learners nationwide;
- WHEREAS, the NFSSLO believes that being committed to hearing learner grievances and concerns will ensure the federation's programs, projects, and activities (PFAs) objectivity and relativity to the field.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NESSLG, to release the National Assessment Form on the State of the Secondary-Level Learners and the Supreme Secondary Learner Government for SY 2023-2024.
- RESOLVED FURTUER, that National Assessment Form form will be distributed via Microsoft Forms among the SLLG Presidents audiouside, thus calculing that it reaches a wide and representative audience:
- **RESOLVED FURTIER**, that National Assessment Form form will contain fourteen (14) major clauses with supporting statements, which is answerable for about fifteen (15) to twenty (20) minutes;
- RESOLVED FURTHER, that the National Assessment Form adheres to the Data Privacy Act of 2012 stipulated under the Republic Act 10173, indicating that the personal details and choices provided by the respondents will be only used solely for the data needed in this National Assessment Form;
- RESOLVED FUNCTIER, that the National Assessment Form will be released in two versions: the English version and the Filipino Version, to ensure the accessibility and inclusivity for all learners, recognizing the linguistic diversity of the learner body across the country.
- RESOLVED FURTHER, that the NFSSLG arges the Department of Education, through the FLSS-YFD to release a memorandum with regards to the strict compliance and participation of all SSLG presidents across the commy to ensure proper representation in all schools and divisions of the country.

- RESOLVED FURTHER, that the NESSLG requests the Division Youth Formation Coordinators (DYFC) and the Regional Youth Formation Coordinators (RYFC) to causare the strict countilance and participation of all SSLG Presidents;
- RESOLVED FURTRIER, that the NESSLG calls upon all the Regional, Division, and District Federation Presidents to take a proactive role in ensuring that all SSLG Presidents answer the assessment form:
- RESOLVED FUNTKER, that the NFSSLG calls upon the Supreme Secondary Learner Governments nationwide to implement the establishment of National Assessment Form that can be further strangthened by holding town half meetings and provide accessible channels where learners can provide their feedback and concerns:
- RESOLVED FURTHER, that the National Assessment Form be distributed at the start of the year 2024, and the SSLG Presidents be given until the 19th of lanuary 2024 to colliste and submit the answers to provide ample time for thorough consideration and comprehensive input from the SSLG Presidents;

- WHEREAS, the National Federation of the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (NFSSLG), comprised of all Regional Presidents of the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG), is at the forefront of championing the rights and welfare of all learners;
- WHEREAS, the NFSSLG is committed to enforce the rights of all learners, recognizing the part the learners play in fostering holistic development and the pursuit of academic, co-curricular, and extra-curricular excellence;
- WHEREAS, the inclusive representation and recognition of learners are of critical importance. It is crucial for the National Federation to initiate the establishment of a platform to ensure equal, inclusive, and diverse representation in decision-making for the development of school and student body policies;

- WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11036, otherwise known as the "Philippine Mental Health Act of 2018," declares the state policy to protect the fundamental rights of persons with mental health needs, provide mental health services, and integrate mental health programs and strategies in the educational system;
- WHEREAS, the Department of Education (DepEd) has recognized the significance of mental health in the learning environment, as indicated in DepEd Order No. 48, s. 2019, which underscores the integration of mental health education in the school curriculum:

#### A RESOLUTION

CALLING FOR THE STRENGTHENING OF THE TOBACCO CONTROL AND ENFORCEMENT MEASURES IN SCHOOLS IN ACCORDANCE WITH REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9211 AND DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 111, S. 2019

- WHEREAS, the National Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government (NFSSLG) composed of all Regional Federation Presidents, is the highest level of the learner government program under the DepEd's Bureau of Learner Support Services—Youth Formation Division.
- WHEREAS, the NFSSLG is committed to promote a safe and healthy environment for all learners, recognizing the role the environment plays in fostering holistic development and the pursuit of academic excellence;
- WHEREAS, the health and well-being of learners and the entire institution are of paramount importance, and it is necessary to advocate for policies that promote and ensure a secure and health-conscious educational environment;
- WHEREAS, the presence of tobacco and smoking within school perimeters poses a direct threat to the health and well-being of learners, teachers, and staff;
- WHEREAS, the Republic Act No. 9211, also known as the Tobacco Regulation Act of 2003, was enacted with the primary objective of regulating and controlling the production, manufacture, sale, and use of tobacco products, with the intent of mitigating the detrimental consequences of tobacco consumption on public health, particularly in educational institutions;
- WHEREAS, Section 10 of Republic Act No. 9211 stipulates that the sale or distribution of tobacco products is prohibited within one hundred (100) meters from any point of the perimeter of a school, public playground, or other facility frequented particularly by minors, emphasizing the importance of creating a protective buffer zone to shield learners and young individuals from the influences of tobacco use within close proximity to educational institutions;





- WHEREAS, Department of Education (DepEd) Memorandum No. 111, s. 2019, was issued to reinforce the absolute tobacco smoking ban in schools and DepEd effices and to prohibit the use of e-eigerettes and other electronic alcother and non-nicotine delivery systems in adventional institutions.
- WHEREAS, in fine with DepFd No. 43, s. 2016, all schools, through their respective Child Protection Committee and all regional and schools division effices, with the technical assistance of their designated Tobacco Control Coordinators, are directed to ensure the strict enforcement of the ban on the distribution, sale, offering, and use of Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS), Electronic Non-Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS), and tobacco products, such as eignrettes, within the premises of all educational institutions and DepEd offices, reiterating the collective responsibility to uphold these areas as tobacco and ENDS/ENNDS-free environments;
- WHEREAS, DepEd Order No. 48, s. 2017 also states that all schools, through their respective Child Protection Committees, and all regional and schools division offices, with the technical assistance of their designated Tobacco Control Condinators, are directed to coordinate and collaborate with their respective local government ands in observing and ensuring the Implementation and of the guidelines provided under DOH AO 2019-0007:
- WHEREAS, curforcement of these measures must be ensured, to prevent and minigate the health risks associated with tobacco use and ENDS, all while fostering an environment conducive to learning and well-being in our educational institutions:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE II RESOLVED BY THE NESSLG, to call for the strengthering and effective implementation of Republic Act No. 9211, the Tobacco Regulation Act of 2003, and DepEd Memorandom No. 111, s. 2019;
- RESOLVED FURTHER, that the NFSSLG advocates for the full support and collaboration of relevant authorities in enforcing the provisions of Republic Act No. 9211 and DepEd Memorandum No. 111, s. 2019, to cusare strict compliance with and the effectiveness of trese regulations in educational institutions:
- RESOLVED FURTHER, that the NFSSLG encourages and empowers learners, teachers, and staff to be vigilant and proactive in reporting any violations of the tobacco regulations:
- RESOLVED FURTHES, that the NESSLO calls upon schools, Supreme Secondary Learner Governments, and other organizations such as the Barkada Kontra Droga to take a projective take in the implementation of comprehensive awareness campugus and educational programs dedicated to informing all learners, teachers, and stati about the hazardous nature of tobacco use and the associated risks of e-eigenettes and other ENOS focused on both prevention strategies and the provision of support for those seeking to cause tobacco use:
- FINALLY, the NESSLG advocates for the establishment of easily accessible and reliable reporting mechanisms to facilitate the reporting process for any violations of the

tobacco regulations, ensuring that all stakeholders can participate effectively in upholding these crucial regulations.

#### **A RESOLUTION**

IN SUPPORT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S BUREAU OF LEARNER SUPPORT SERVICES—LEARNER FORMATION DIVISION'S (LFD) CRAFTING OF AN OPERATIONS MANUAL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATIONS OF SCHOOL CAMPUS COORDINATING COUNCIL OF RECOGNIZED CLUBS AND ORGANIZATION

- WHEREAS, the National Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government (NFSSLG) composed of all Regional Federation Presidents, is the highest level of the learner government program under the DepEd's Bureau of Learner Support Services—Youth Formation Division.
- WHEREAS, clubs and organizations have been vital to learners' growth and development in some public elementary and secondary schools, whether it hones their academic skills and interests.
- WHEREAS, there are active clubs and organizations introduced and currently administered or overseen by the Bureau of Learner Support Services-Learner Formation Division, such as Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD), Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O), School Sports Club, and Red Cross Youth (RCY).
- WHEREAS, Article XII of the new Bylaws and Constitution of the Supreme Elementary and Secondary Learner Governments (SELG/SSLG) indicates the establishment of a coordinating council of all campus co-curricular clubs and organizations, which shall be headed by the SSLG President and guided by the school head as the council adviser.
- WHEREAS, the same article also discusses the functions and other provisions needed for the continuous operation and establishment of the coordinating council, specifically the council committees, council advisorship, council chairmanship, council member qualifications, and council meeting details.





- WOEREAS, there is no clear mendate for the limitations or boundaries of the council, the definition of terms needed for the operation of the council, council meeting procedures, council documents, or even the description of the process of club and organization accreditation and re-accreditation.
- WHEREAS, the process of recognizing club and organization accorditation and to-accreditation is also stated as one of the duties and responsibilities of the SELG/SSLG, which mandates them to recommend clubs and organizations to the school head in order to function as legitimate clubs and organizations offective for one (1) whole school year.
- WHENEAS, during the NESSLG Meeting for the validation of the National Assessment Form on the State of the Secondary-Level Learners and the Supreme Secondary Learner Government for SY 2023-2024, one of the main concerns that the NESSLG wants to determine from the perception and experiences of the SSLG Presidents is the establishment and operation of a coordinating council at their respective school, which will help to determine how effective or functional the coordinating council is mendated in the SELG/SSLG Bylews and Consistuation.
- WHEREAS, crafting the operations manual for the Coordinating Council of Campus Co-curricular Chibs and Organizations, under the leadership of the BLSS-Learner Foundation Division, will belot be SSLAs lay a strong foundation for the establishment of the council with the vision of having harmonious working relationships between all chibs and organizations.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOUVED BY THE NUSSLC, to request the Learner Formation Division of the Department of Education to craft an operations manual for the establishment and operations of the Campus Coordinating Council of Co-certicular Clubs and Organizations.
- **RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the Yorth Formation Division (YFD) is requested to invite all the officers and bound rusmbers of the National Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government on the crafting of the operations meanual for inputs and suggestions.
- RESOLVED FURTIFEM, that the results from the National Assessment Form on the State of the Secondary-Level Learners and the Supreme Secondary Learner Government for SY 2023-2024 under the Formation of the Chib/Organization Coordinating Council inside the School be evaluated to dropped the condition of the coordinating council in our secondary schools and formulate possible interventions that can be added on as soon as the necessary data are obtained by the NFSSLG and the YFD.
- RESOLVED FINALLY, that this initiative be included as part of the National Pederation's General Plan of Action for SY 2023-2024.
