Grant of CTO may be applicable to situations such as when personnel need to travel a day before the opening (Sunday) or a day after the closing (Saturday) due to the availability of flights, or when a day or some days within the duration of the activity fall/s under (a) [local] holiday(s).
- c. Subsequent announcements related to the activities for the finalization of the policy shall be made through separate issuances or correspondences from the BLSS.

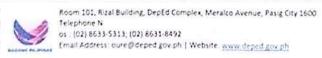

CONCEPT NOTE

I. Background

The Department of Education prioritizes the promotion and protection of the mental health and general welfare of learners and its personnel, with DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2020, also known as the Required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools, highlights the provision of Mental Health and Psychosocial Support Services to improve and strengthen the mental resilience of all learners. These were likewise emphasized in the MATATAG Agenda, which is to TAke good care of our learners by promoting their well-being and supporting teachers to teach better.

According to the World Health Organization¹, suicide is the 4th leading cause of death among 15-29 year-olds, and 77% of global suicides occur in low- and middle-income countries. Psychiatrists' link a strong correlation between adolescents' time spent online and their mental health. Those who spend more time on social networking, television, and the internet have a higher risk of developing depressive symptoms that may have contributed to suicide, suicidal attempts, and suicidal ideations.3

Mental health conditions could be life-threatening and a lifelong struggle that requires a strong support system that will build the groundwork for better mental health and wellbeing. Protecting learners from adversity, promoting socio-emotional learning and psychological well-being, and ensuring access to mental health care are among our goals.

Good mental health is required because it helps them adjust well and develop good behaviors, communication skills, and intellectual, emotional, and social skills that lead to self-assured adults. Thus, the importance of mental health must be recognized at every stage of life, from childhood to adolescence and adulthood. Another important part of having good mental health is building resilience. This is when one can cope with unexpected changes and challenges in life by drawing on inner strength and using all options around.

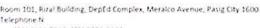
II. Objective:
