Background

The Institute of APEC Collaborative Education (IACE) under the auspice of the Ministry of Education (MOE), Republic of Korea, in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd), will be conducting the 2024 ALCoB ICT Volunteer (AIV) from July 22-26, 2024.

Since 2001, AIV has been contributing to narrowing the digital divide, particularly among teachers, in the region for the past 20 years in close cooperation with member economies by providing a locus for teachers in the region to exchange best practices of utilizing ICT in education

The 2023 AIV Training Program was conducted in Davao City and participated by thirty-seven (37) teachers. Korean expert teachers and AIV Filipino alumni facilitated the training to strengthen Filipino teachers' class capacity and provide cultural experience opportunities based on Korea's ICT-based teaching method and collaborative learning.

For this year, the Korean Ministry of Education (KMOE) and IACE are planning to dispatch five (5) Korean volunteer teachers and **two (2) IACE program specialists to the Philippines.** Its overarching objective is to share an inter-regional comparative perspective on the usage and impact of ICT in the school curriculum trends, issues, and strategies.
