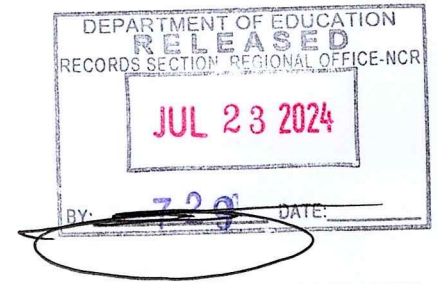

**REGIONAL GUIDELINES ON TEACHING AND LEARNING RESOURCES FOR  
SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025**

1. The Department of Education – National Capital Region (DepEd-NCR) in view of its steadfast support to the MATATAG Agenda and the implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum, and in line with the Region’s Top 5 Priorities, has engaged in the development, redevelopment, enhancement and quality assurance of teaching and learning resources for utilization this School Year 2024-2025.

2. For the mandatory implementation of Kinder, Grades 1, 4 and 7, the Region has procured printing and delivery services from the Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR) downloaded funds for the RO- developed, redeveloped and enhanced transition lesson exemplars (LEs) and worksheets (WS), in the following learning areas while awaiting completion of procurement and delivery of textbooks (TXs) and teacher’s manuals (TMs), except for Grade 1 Mathematics which will use LEs and WSs for the entire school year:

Kindergarten	
Grade 1	GMRC, Makabansa, Language, Reading and Literacy, Mathematics
Grade 4	Music and Arts
Grade 7	English, Filipino, AP, Values Education, Music & Arts, TLE



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The distribution list of these resources among Schools Division Offices is on a percentage basis based on the given quantity by the Central Office (CO) and the size of enrolment for SY 2023-2024. Digital copies of the lesson exemplars and worksheets for the other learning areas, as well as the CO ready-to-print copies of the same, may be accessed through the Regional LRMS One Drive.

The Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and its Learning Resource Management Section (LRMS), the development and quality assurance teams have exercised utmost diligence in ensuring that the resources are standards compliant and free from copyright concerns. However, should there be concerns that may arise from its utilizations on these areas, such are never intentional or deliberate.

The Lesson exemplars are suggestive in nature. It is designed to guide teachers in enhancing their teaching practices to further deepen their knowledge in other forms of classroom delivery. Further, these lesson exemplars shall not limit the creativity of teachers, they may enhance, revise, adjust the materials according to the needs of their learners.

3. For all other grade levels and subject areas (including those which are not for phase implementation), while awaiting for the MATATAG Curriculum TXs and TMs to be delivered, current TXs and TMs and Learner's Materials (LMs), supplemented by Self-Learning Modules (SLMs) shall be utilized, including the electronic version of the TMs and LEs.

4. For the pilot implementation of Grades 2, 3, 5 and 8, Program Support Fund for the printing and delivery of teaching and learning resources shall be downloaded to the pilot SDO. The link to the CO drive of materials shall be shared with the SDO LRMS Education Program Supervisor for downloading and creation of local drive for sharing to the pilot schools.

5. Resources may also be accessed through the various CO platforms. The Region has also a collection of supplementary learning resources across grade levels and learning areas, which may be accessed through the local LR portal.
