SCHOOL PROFILE

At the turn of the century, a distinguished Methodist institution of higher learning was established in the heart of Metro Manila. This endeavor was inspired and driven by the vision of Manila Episcopal Area Bishop, Dr. Emerito P. Nacpil. Prominent Methodist leaders, including Dr. Carlito S. Puno, Atty. Rodolfo C. Beltran (Chair of the Board of Trustees, Wesleyan University-Philippines, Cabanatuan), Atty. Leven S. Puno (Vice-Chair of the Board of Trustees, Wesleyan University-Philippines, Cabanatuan), Ms. Liz Pajaro-Mariano, Ms. Perla E. Cenon, and the Board of Trustees of Wesleyan University-Philippines (WU-P) Cabanatuan, were committed to bringing this vision to fruition. Together, they nurtured this vision until it became a reality with the establishment of Wesleyan University-Philippines Manila in June 2000 as a branch of WU-P Cabanatuan. A Management Committee, chaired by Atty. Leopoldo Serrano, Jr., was formed to oversee the affairs of WU-P Manila.

The early days of Wesleyan Manila were characterized by the challenges and frustrations typical of any nascent institution, a period aptly described as "growing pains." However, the unwavering support from the WU-P Cabanatuan Board and the nurturing guidance of the Management Committee helped the institution navigate these early struggles.

History

From June to August 2000, WU-P Manila was initially housed at the CRS Tower in Paco, Manila. However, due to space constraints, certain requirements set by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) could not be met. Consequently, in September 2000, Wesleyan Manila relocated to the corner of Taft Avenue and President Quirino Avenue in Malate, Manila. With the assistance of CHED Commissioner Kate Botengan and Bishop Emerito P. Nacpil, the CHED NCR Director granted permission to proceed with operations on the condition that a more suitable venue or campus be secured as soon as possible. Just before the expiration of the grace period granted by CHED, the administrators of WU-P Manila identified a suitable lot for purchase. Following the Board of Trustees' approval, negotiations were swiftly conducted, and construction began within a month. Despite the challenges faced, the university turned obstacles into opportunities, demonstrating resilience and determination during its early stages of growth. As Romans 8:28 reminds us, "God causes all things to work together for good to those who love Him and to those who are called according to His purpose."

The vision for WU-P Manila and other branches of WU-P Cabanatuan to achieve autonomy was realized when the Securities and Exchange Commission approved the incorporation of Wesleyan College of Manila on June 18, 2003. The incorporators and members of the Board of Wesleyan College of Manila are active and distinguished Methodist leaders. The newly appointed members of the Board of Trustees are as follows:

Today, Wesleyan College of Manila proudly stands on its current site at the corner of Leveriza Street and Balagtas Street in Pasay City. As the only Methodist institution of higher learning in Metro Manila, it embraces the challenge of carving out a distinct place and making a significant impact in the academic realm.


