SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) SY 2024-2025

- 1. Attached is the Memorandum OUPS No. 2024-09-04944 dated June 13, 2024, from Atty. Revsee A. Escobedo, Undersecretary for Operations, and Dr. Dexter A. Galban, Assistant Secretary for Operation of DepEd Central Office, Pasig City, entitled: Fifth Advisory for the Implementation of School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) SY 2024-2025.
- 2. With the revision of the schedule of School Year (SY) 2024-2025, the following updates and instructions are hereby issued:

#### 2.1 Number of Feeding Days

- 2.1.1. The maximum number of feeding days shall be 160 days with an additional 15 days for the National Learning Camp (NLC) in Calendar Year (CY) 2025, for a total of 175 days (SY 2024-2025).
- 2.1.2. The number of feeding days can be adjusted accordingly to accommodate more beneficiaries but shall be minimum of 120 days and not exceeding 160 days.
- 2.1.3. The feeding shall begin simultaneously across all schools from August 19, 2024 until April 15, 2025. Holidays are to be included in the counting of feeding days.
- 2.1.4. Conduct of double feeding shall be officially requested through a letter and subject to approval of the Regional Director.

## 2.2 Increase in the number of target beneficiaries

- 2.2.1. The Revised Breakdown of Allocation is attached as Annex A.
- 2.2.2 Negative variance on the downloaded funds from the adjusted number of beneficiaries can be covered by the SDO's program support funds. Alternatively, any savings incurred can be used as program support funds.
- 2.2.3 The additional beneficiaries shall cover the following according to priority: a. All Kinder in as many schools with the highest SW/W learners based on percentage shall be prioritized.







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- b. All elementary learners who will participate in the 2025 NLC can be included if there are still excess funds.
- c. Feeding can be extended to secondary beneficiaries to fulfill the adjusted number of beneficiaries.

## 2.3 Payment of Nutritious Food Products (NFP) and Milk

- 2.3.1 All SDOs are advised to adopt a staggered payment scheme for NFP and Milk. Obligations and disbursements shall be reported monthly in the Financial sheet of the Progress Report of the region on this link: https://tinyurl.com/SBFP-NCR-PR-2024
- 2.3.2 All payments for the deliveries for 2023 NFP and Milk shall be paid completely as soon as possible.

# 2.4 Use of Negotiated Procurement-Community Participation (NP-CP) and Catering Services

- 2.4.1 The use of NP-CP is highly encouraged for the procurement of milk products and may also be used for hot meals and NFP. Other modes of procurement resorted to are subject to existing rules and regulations of procurement law.
- 2.4.2 The procurement of catering services may also be used for serving hot meals.

# 2.5 Monitoring of Downloaded Funds and Additional Contract of Service (COS) Personnel Hired

- 2.5.1 All SDOs are requested to update the (a)status of downloaded funds for the procurement of deworming medicines and soaps, Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP), Integrated School Nutrition Model (ISNM), and (b) COS hired by the ROs and SDOs by accessing the following links:

#### 2.6 Revision in the Milk Recommendations


#### 2.7 Implementation Timeline for SY 2024-2025

- 2.7.1. The implementation timelines for the regular and milk components for SY 2024-2025 are hereby issued as Annex B for ready reference.
- 2.7.2. The implementation timelines for pre-procurement and procurement activities serves as a guide only and subject to change with the recent issuance of the 5<sup>th</sup> Advisory for the Implementation of SBFP for SY 2024-2025. Schedules of Nutritional Assessment, Distribution of Milk and Hot Meals and/or NFP and Payments must be followed accordingly.









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# 2.8 Submission of Program Terminal Reports for SY 2023-2024

2.8.1. All SDOs are requested to submit their <u>Program Terminal Reports for SY</u> 2023-2024 on or before July 15, 2024 to the Regional Office for consolidation and submission to the Central Office.

# 2.9 Hiring of Technical Assistant I for Central Kitchen and Admin Support for SDOs

- 2.9.1. The hiring of Technical Assistant I (COS) for central kitchens who will serve as the Food Service Supervisor may be charged against the SDO Program Support Funds (PSF) with the approval of the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) and subject to the accounting and auditing rules and regulations and availability of funds.
- 2.9.2 SDOs may hire more than one Admin Support (COS) for SBFP with the approval of the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) and subject to the accounting and auditing rules and regulations and availability of funds.

# 2.10 Reiteration of the Policy on the Removal of Administrative Tasks for Teaching Personnel

- 2.10.1. The implementation of SBFP shall comply with DepEd Order No.02, s.2024, Immediate Removal of Administrative Tasks to Public School Teachers.
- 2.10.2 Request for school level procurement or school clustering shall be made through a letter subject to approval of the Regional Director and strict compliance with the DO No. 02, s.2024.
- 3. All previous DepEd Orders on SBFP shall remain in effect and shall be referred to in the implementation of SBFP for SY 2024-2025.







This Advisory provides new instructions regarding the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for School Year (SY) 2024-2025. With the revision of the schedule of School Year (SY) 2024-2025, the following updates and instructions are hereby issued:

#### 1. Number of Feeding days

The number of feeding days shall be **160 days** with an additional **15 days** for the National Learning Camp (NLC) in Calendar Year (CY) 2025, for a total of one hundred seventy-five **(175) feeding days**.

The feeding shall begin **simultaneously** across all schools from **August 19, 2024**, until **April 15, 2025**. Holidays will be included in the counting of feeding days.

Attached as Annex A is the Revised Breakdown of Beneficiaries for ready reference.

# 2. Increase in the number of target beneficiaries


The revised number of feeding days is expected to result in an increase in the number of beneficiaries. The additional beneficiaries shall cover the following according to priority:

- a. all Kinder in as many schools with the highest SW/W learners based on percentage (%) enrollment;
- b. if there are still excess, include all elementary learners who will participate in the 2025 NLC;











c. If there are still excess, include the secondary beneficiaries as stated in D.O. No. 31, s. 2021.

# 3. Payment of Nutritious Food Products (NFP) and Milk

All SDOs are advised to adopt a **staggered payment scheme** for NFP and Milk. This approach involves distributing the payments over a period rather than making a single lump sum payment.

For efficiency, staggered payment schedule allows for more efficient handling of transactions, and immediate processing of smaller payments. This will also result in better utilization of funds throughout the period.

It is also expected that all payments for the deliveries for 2023 NFP and milk shall be paid completely as soon as possible.

# 4. Use of the Negotiated Procurement-Community Participation (NP-CP) and Catering Services

The use of NP-CP is highly encouraged for the procurement of milk products and may also be used for hot meals and NFP. Other modes of procurement resorted to are subject to existing rules and regulations of procurement law.

The procurement of catering services may also be used for serving hot meals.

# 5. Monitoring of Downloaded Funds and Additional Contract of Service (COS) Personnel Hired

All SDOs are requested to update the (a) status of downloaded funds for the procurement of deworming medicines and soaps, *Gulayan sa Paaralan* (GPP), Integrated School Nutrition Model (ISNM), operating funds and COS-hiring for central kitchen training centers, (b) COS hired by the ROs and SDOs by accessing the following links:

#### 6. Revisions in the Milk Recommendations

All SDO focal persons are requested to revise the milk recommendations in the milk supply mapping document on or before June 28, 2024, using this link:



The SDOs will recommend schools that can be supplied with Pasteurized Milk (PM), Sterilized Milk (SM), and Commercial Milk (CM). Pasteurized and/or sterilized milk sourced from local dairy farmers and cooperatives are the type of milk to be served to the SBFP beneficiaries in accordance with RA No. 11037. Remote or far-flung schools, mountainous schools, and schools in hard-to-reach areas shall be prioritized for supply of sterilized milk. CM (Powdered or ready-to-drink milk) shall be allowed in areas identified by the SDO and validated by the RO that cannot be reached or very difficult to be delivered with sterilized milk because of extraordinary/harsh conditions.











Procurement of CM shall also be allowed only in SDOs that are either not covered or are insufficiently covered by the National Dairy Authority (NDA)/Philippine Carabao Center (PCC)-assisted Community Social Groups (CSGs). Such SDOs may be allowed to procure commercial powdered/sterilized milk, subject to the following pre-requisites:

- a. Written request from the Schools Division Office (SDO) to the Regional Office (RO) seeking approval of the procurement of commercial milk (CM) with justification; and
- b. The RO, through the SBFP Focal Person, shall validate if these areas are indeed far-flung/inaccessible and provide a recommendation to proceed with the procurement of CM.

#### 7. Implementation Timeline for SY 2024-2025

The implementation timelines for the regular and milk components for SY 2024-2025 are hereby issued as Annex B for ready reference.

## 9. Hiring of Technical Assistant I for Central Kitchen

The hiring of Technical Assistant I for central kitchens who will serve as the Food Service Supervisor may be charged against the SDO Program Support Funds (PSF) with the approval of the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) and subject to the accounting and auditing rules and regulations, and availability of funds.

#### 10. Reiteration of the Policy on the Removal of Administrative Tasks for Teaching Personnel

The implementation of SBFP shall comply with Deped Order No. 2, s. 2024, Immediate Removal of Administrative Tasks to Public School Teachers, thus it is reiterated to strategize and mobilize the non-teaching staff and other volunteers to assist in the implementation.


