

## ADDENDUM TO REGIONAL MEMORANDUM NO. 729 s. 2024

- 1. Private schools may also opt to utilize the teaching and learning resources in the drives given, as references and/or supplements to their default materials. They are likewise informed that these materials have been subjected to quality assurance, revision and finalization. However, should there still be any error in content, grammar and computation that may be observed, such are not intentional and deliberate, and should be reported immediately to the Schools Division Office.
- 2. SDOs are advised to coordinate with the schools the allocation and delivery of the K, Grades 1,4, and 7 transition materials that they will receive for immediate pull-out. Excess lesson exemplars (LEs) may be stored for future utilization and/or transferred to other schools which may be of need for the same.
- 3. Central Office-procured textbooks (TX) and teacher's manual ™ are also being delivered. For Grade 4, delivery is at the SDO (if no district office), while for Grade 7 it is direct to the schools.
- 4. The drive to the Lesson Scripts, Catch-up Fridays, NMP, and NRP materials has been shared with the SDO LRMS Education Program Supervisors. They are directed to create a local drive to be shared among the schools.
- 5. Old resources for Kinder, Grades 1, 4 and 7, which are in good condition may still be used as reference /supplementary materials. This will include the KAS for Kinder with blue cover.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

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
