The Department of Education (DepEd) enjoins all learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel, officials, and stakeholders, including parents, to actively engage in the activities of the 2024 Nutrition Month Celebration with the theme **“Sa PPAN: Sama-sama sa Nutrisyong Sapat Para sa Lahat.”**

By virtue of the Presidential Decree No. 491 (Nutrition Act of the Philippines) dated June 25, 1974, July has been designated as Nutrition Month for the purpose of creating greater awareness among Filipinos on the importance of nutrition. The said celebration is being led by the National Nutrition Council (NNC), the country’s highest policy-making body and coordinating agency on nutrition.

The Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition (PPAN) 2023-2028 is an ambitious plan as it targets substantive improvements in the so-called triple burden of malnutrition, which is consistent with the United Nations’ Sustainable Development Goals, particularly in ending hunger and eliminating all forms of malnutrition.

The 50th Nutrition Month Celebration aims to:



- a. increase awareness and generate participation and commitments for increased support for the PPAN among stakeholders from government, local government units, non-government organizations, business, civil society and communities; and
- b. advocate for full adoption of the PPAN in local nutrition action plans.

To support the celebration, all DepEd offices, including central, regional, schools division offices, and schools, are encouraged to undertake activities aligned with the 2024 Nutrition Month theme, such as but not limited to:

- a. conduct of different online activities through posting and sharing of 2024 Nutrition Month campaign materials on the websites and social media platforms of all DepEd offices;
- b. integration of nutrition concepts in classroom-based activities; and
- c. organizing relevant activities for learners and their families, such as seminars, webinars, lectures, exhibits, etc.
