1. The Department of Education – National Capital Region through the Learner Rights and Protection Section (Formerly Child Protection Unit) will hold a training workshop entitled, “**Child Protection Committee (CPC) Functionality Training Workshop**” on September 3-6, 2024. The venue will be determined once the procurement process has been completed.
2. This is in line with the MATATAG Flagship Program of the Department of Education, particularly the third component: **Take good care of learners by promoting learners’ well-being, inclusive education, and a positive learning environment** and Top 4 priority program for the next 3 years of the DepEd-National Capital Region, specifically “**Ensure Learner-Centered Environment.**” In addition, this complies with the Learner Rights and Protection mandates that all learners shall be ensured of protection from violence, exploitation, discrimination, bullying, and other forms of abuse in schools where their right to quality and inclusive education is respected,



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protected, promoted, and fulfilled and in consonance with DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 or the “Child Protection Policy.”

3. This 4-day event aims to capacitate the School Division Offices LRP Focals and Schools’ Child Protection Committee with their functionality to ensure the implementation of the Child Protection Policy at the school level.
4. The expected participants are the Division Learner Rights and Protection Focal Persons, Div Alternates, and one (1) Registered Guidance Counselor. Expected participants (*Enclosure A*) shall register on or before August 27, 2024, at this link: <https://tinyurl.com/LRPO-Training>
5. Program arrangements are as follows:
 - The Opening Program shall commence on September 3, 2024 (Day 1) at 1:00 PM, with AM snacks as the first meal. The standard hour for the check-in of participants is between 11:00 AM – 12:00 NN;
 - Participants are enjoined to observe punctuality and active learning involvement during the activity;
 - SDOs and Schools’ Guidance Counselors are requested to carry out a flexible mechanism to ensure the continuity of their operations while attending the activity;
 - Checkout of participants, Program Management Team, and Resource Persons will be on September 6, 2024 (Day 4), at noon NN.
6. Enclosed is the Indicative Program of Activities (*Enclosure B*). Only those participants who completed the prescribed hours and submitted the activity requirements shall be given a Certificate of Participation.



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7. Travel expenses shall be charged against local funds, while the board and lodging of the participants shall be charged from the LRPO-CO Program Support Funds (PSF), subject to the usual COA rules and regulations.
