NATIONAL TRAINING OF SPORTS CLUB FACILITATORS ON THE TEACHING OF SPORTS SPECIFIC SKILLS

- Pursuant to the attached Memorandum OM-OUOPS-2024-10-07365 dated September 9, 2024, titled *National Training of Sports Club Facilitators on the Teaching of Sports Specific Skills*, the said national training is slated in October onwards at **Teachers' Camp, Baguio City**. The training aims to equip participants with the necessary skills and knowledge for effective sports management and to highlight the role of sports in learner development.
- In this connection, the Schools Divisions are requested to send participants during the Cluster 2 schedule (Southern Luzon - IVA, IV-B, V and NCR) on **October 7-10, 2024**, in Baguio City. Each SDO is enjoined to send *one (1)* authorized Sports Officer of the Division and *two (2)* *facilitators* to be designated for School Sports (per Sports) who possess the knowledge of their chosen sport. Preferably MAPEH teacher, former student-athlete or with experience/engagement in sports activities. The participants are required to bring their travel authority and Medical Certificate stating that he/she is medically and physically fit for the training. Participants shall pre-register through this link <https://bit.ly/NTSSS2024> **until September 25, 2024, 11:00 pm only**.
- The sports covered are the following namely: Arnis, Dancesport, Pencak Silat, Table Tennis, Speak Takraw and Wushu. The participants are reminded to bring the necessary equipment as required in the said Memorandum. Further, the Division Sports Officers are requested to submit their respective list of participants to this Office (Attention: Ms. Joan R. Pedroche, PDO IV, OIC Chief ESSD) on September 25, 2024, for consolidation and submission to BLSS.
- Board and lodging of participants shall be charged against FY 2024 Physical Fitness and School Sports Fund while the travel and incidental expenses shall be charged against their respective local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

In line with the Department of Education's (DepEd) mission to foster holistic learner development, the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Sports Division (BLSS-SSD) is dedicated to enhancing this agenda through sports and physical activities. Active engagement in these areas is recognized as crucial to the comprehensive development of learners. To support this, the BLSS-SSD is focused on establishing School Sports Clubs to promote physical fitness, health, and engagement among learners. It is also an avenue for learners to discover and develop their sports potentials. In relation, this Office has developed the DepEd Sports Manual covering thirty (30) sports including paragames.

The DepEd Sports Manual provides essential guides and instructions for the School Sports Club Program, aiming to improve learners' skills across different sports disciplines. To implement this, Sports Skills Training sessions will be conducted from October 2024 onwards at Teacher's Camp, Baguio City, and the training shall be divided into five (5) clusters. This initiative is designed to equip participants with the necessary skills and knowledge for effective sports management and to highlight the role of sports in learner development. In addition, this training will impart best practices, techniques, and values across various sports, thereby empowering participants with confidence and competence needed to lead and support capacity building efforts among other sports stakeholders. These sessions will underscore the importance of sports in addressing the developmental needs of learners, facilitating their engagement in physical activities to promote health and growth.

Sports Covered	Arnis, Dancesport, Pencak Silat, Table Tennis, Sepaktakraw and Wushu.

Preferably MAPEH teacher, former student-athlete, or with experience/engagement in sports activities. - Shall bring/wear appropriate comfortable and easy-to-move-in clothing.
Participants Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Travel Authority - Certification stating that he/she is medically and physically fit for the training
Equipment Requirements	
Arnis	Bring your own Arnis Stick
Table Tennis	Bring one paddle and one ball
Sepaktakraw	Bring Sepaktakraw ball each
Dancesport	Bring danceshoes, if available

All concerned are enjoined to authorize the participants to attend and participate to the aforementioned activity.

Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of the training such as food, accommodation, supplies and materials, rental of venues and miscellaneous expenses shall be charged against FY 2024 Physical Fitness and School Sports Fund. Traveling expenses of participants shall be charged against their respective local funds. Further traveling expenses of the resource persons/lecturers and management staff shall be charged against FY 2024 Physical Fitness and School Sports Funds.

All abovementioned expenses shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
